Ice Age National Scenic Trail

In 1980, the Ice Age Trail was authorized as a National Scenic Trail by the United States Congress. The approximately 1,100-mile trail generally follows the farthest southern extent of the most recent glacial advance. The Ice Age Trail is one of eight National Scenic Trails within the United States, and is one of only two contained within a single state.

- Madison Metropolitan School District & Verona Area School District
