Southwest Area Plan Boundaries


North boundary: Beltline Hwy



Madison Arts Commission & Opportunities

- MAC consists of ten residents and one Alder
- One full-time and two part-time staff support this work.
- Since 1974 MAC has guided the Mayor & Common Council on arts policies and operated arts programs.
- Mission: Encourage artistic activities and initiate cultural programs that integrate, support, and advance arts and culture as an essential part of life in Madison.


