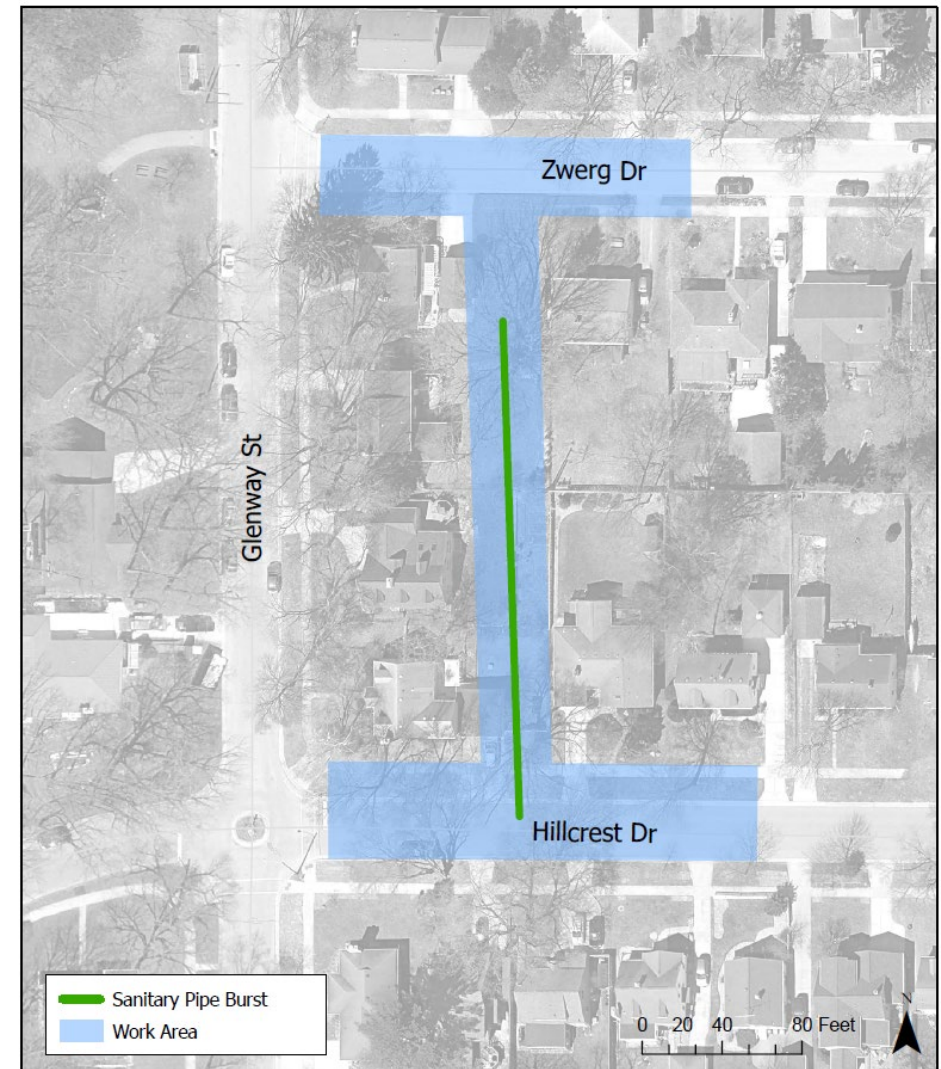
# Project Location and Limits

- Sanitary main behind 131, 135, 139 and 143 Glenway St
- Upstream manhole behind 131 Glenway St, downstream manhole on Hillcrest Dr
- Work area includes portions of Zwerg Dr and Hillcrest Dr
  - Possible staging area for construction vehicles and equipment
  - Sanitary replacement will extend approximately 10' into Hillcrest Dr to connect to sewer main at the manhole in Hill Crest Drive



# Project Background & Purpose

- Existing Conditions:
  - 6" VP sanitary main installed in 1947
  - Lined in 2015
  - Liner is delaminating
- Reasons to Replace:
  - Failing liner requires frequent maintenance from City crews to prevent backups
  - Removing and replacing the liner is not feasible due to the pipe size



# 8" Sanitary Main Lined in 2015

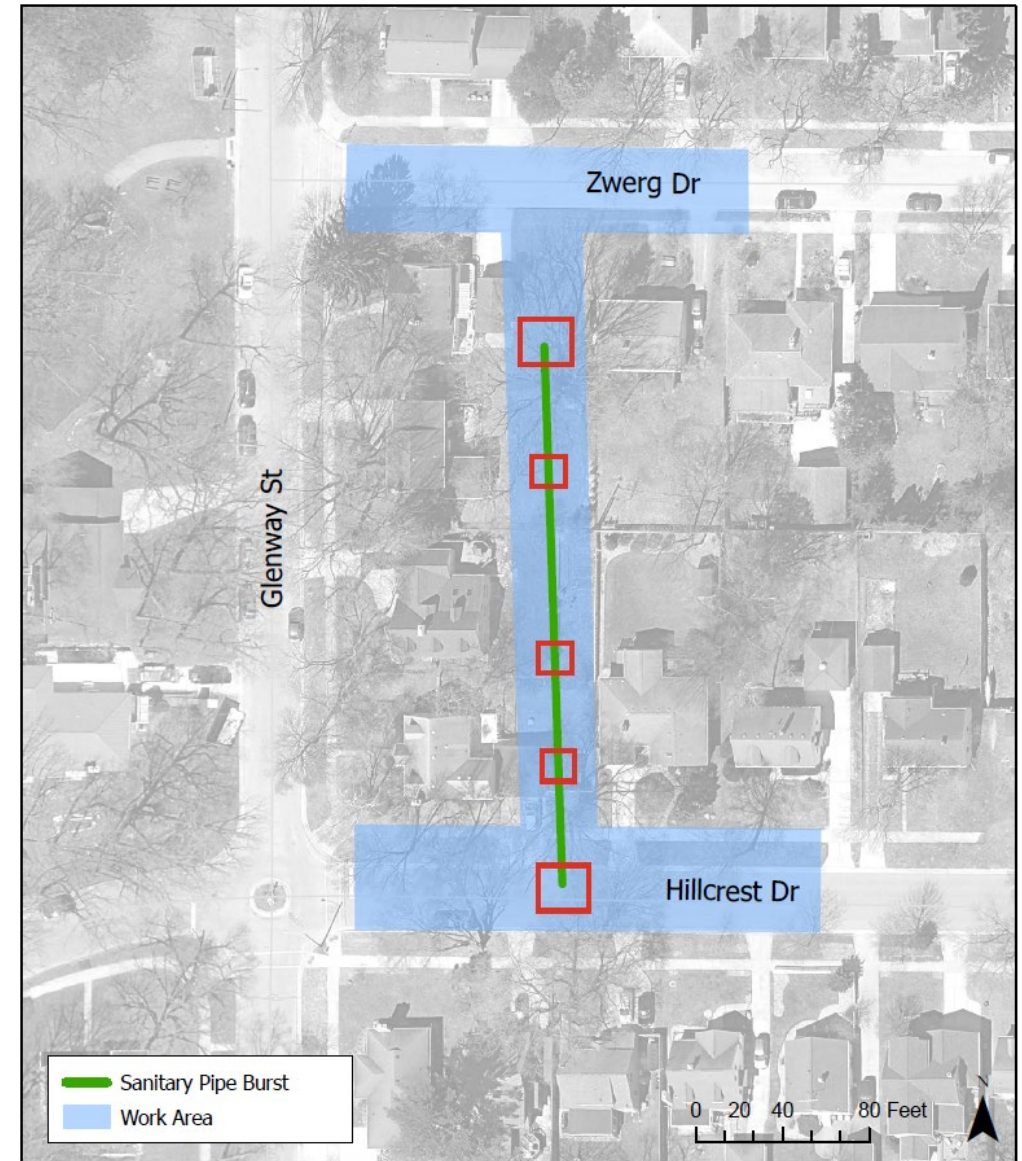

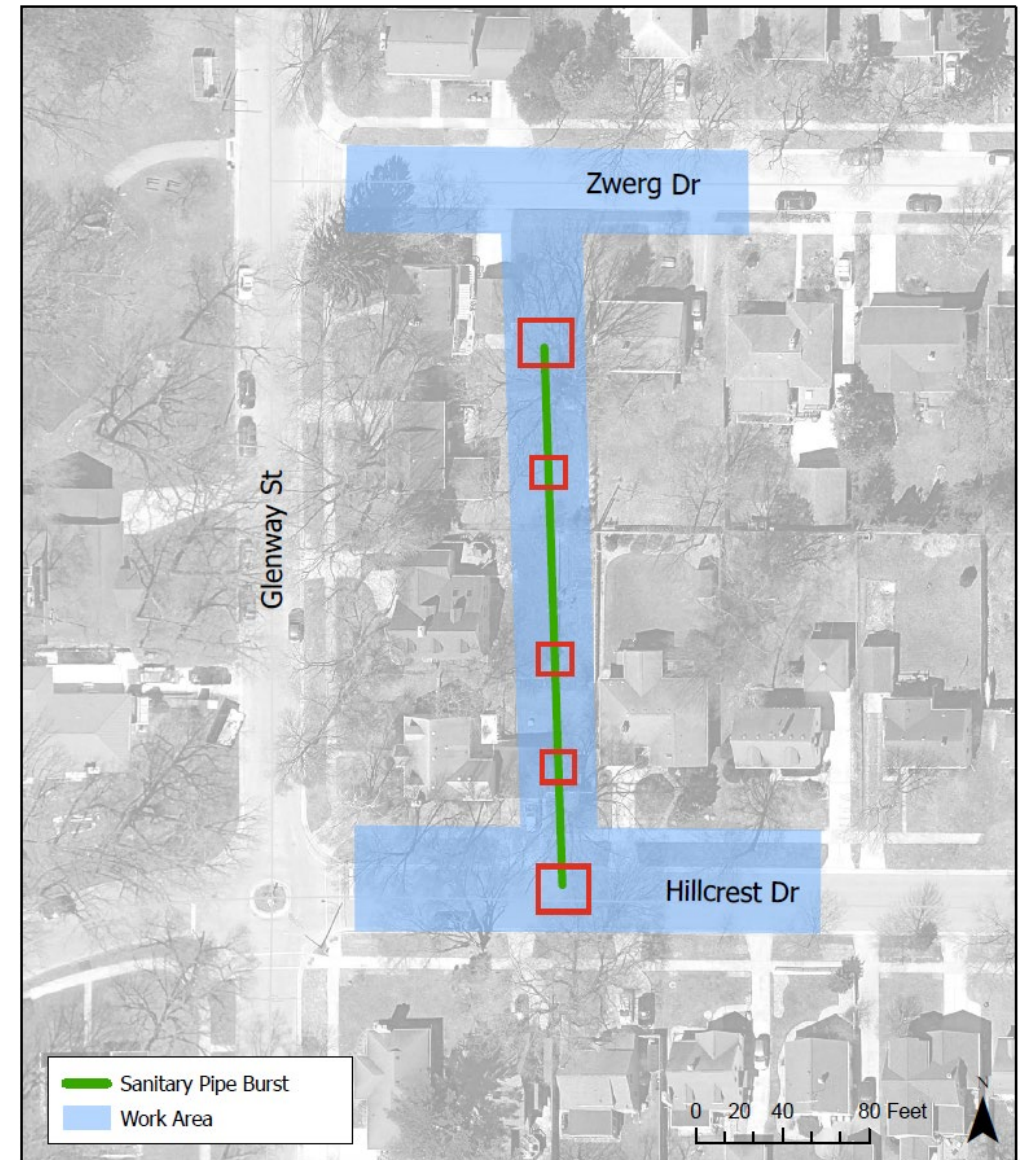
# Project Scope

- Existing pipe will be replaced with 8" PVC pipe via pipe bursting
- Trenchless replacement method
  - Launching and receiving access pits at upstream and downstream manholes
  - Expansion head breaks apart existing pipe while the new pipe is pulled behind
  - Excavation required to reconnect sanitary laterals



# General Pipe Bursting Steps

- Construct access pits at upstream and downstream manholes
- Disconnect sanitary services
- Burst old pipe and pull new pipe into place
- Pressure-test the new pipe
- Tie new pipe into the existing system
- Reconnect services



# Impacts to Residents

- Pipe bursting limits impacts, does not eliminate them
- Residents at 131, 135, 139 and 143 Glenway St can expect:
  - Backyard access for construction equipment
  - Potential impacts to landscaping due to lateral reconnection
  - Minimize water use and refrain from running the dishwasher or doing laundry during pipe burst



# Construction & Access

- Impacted residents will be notified by mail two weeks prior to the start of construction
  - Best guess construction timeframe: Fall 2026
  - Driveway access and water service should not be interrupted during construction
- Standard work hours 7am-7pm Mon-Sat; 10am-7pm Sun
  - No weekend work anticipated
- Disturbed bare ground will be restored with topsoil, grass seed, and mulch
  - Disturbed asphalt roadway will be resurfaced upon completion
  - Disturbed areas of private property will be restored to be equivalent to the preexisting conditions
- Two-way traffic on Zwerg Dr and Hillcrest Dr to be maintained to the greatest extent feasible
  - May be reduced during certain construction activities
- On-Street parking may be limited in the project work area

# Preliminary Project Schedule

- June 16, 2026: Public Information Meeting (tonight)
- July 8, 2026: BPW Public Hearing
- July 21, 2026: Common Council Hearing
- Summer 2026: Advertise for Bids
- Fall 2026: Begin Construction
- Fall 2026: End Construction
  - There is a chance that the project could be delayed depending on available funding.
