RE: Hawks Landing North Flood Mitigation - Start of Construction


The City of Madison is planning to begin work this winter on the pond construction immediately north of Hill Creek Drive. Utility, storm sewer, and associated street work that is also part of this project is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2023 when the weather is more favorable. MG&E will also be working on replacement of gas main on Red Tail Drive to accommodate the storm sewer improvements in the spring. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with construction details on the project and a list of contacts. The contract for this work has been awarded to R.G. Huston Company, Inc.

The work under the City contract, starting with the pond construction, is expected to begin the week of January 9, 2023. The allowed work hours are 7AM to 7PM Monday through Saturday and 10AM – 7PM on Sundays. More details on the project and access during construction can be found on the enclosed fact sheet.
