






Existing Stone Wall











Background

- Constructed on WDOT Property
- City of Madison Engineering has a lease agreement with WDOT to maintain this property
- 2018 Preliminary Assessment Conducted by InSite Architects Recommending Reconstruction of Wall to address two failing points
- 2021 Storm Construction and repair pipe undermining at culvert
- 2023 \$100K adopted in Capitol Budget for Repair

- Historical Status
 - 1847 Wall built prior to Park
 - Wisconsin State Historical Society determine "no review Under SS 66.1111, only review if state or national registered properties"
 - Landmarks Commission Not part of park landmark
