WORK:
CONSTRUCT NEW PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE OVER STARKWEATHER CREEK

DURATION: ANTICIPATED TO BE 1 TO 2 MONTHS

USER IMPACTS:

- PATH USERS NEAR THE CREEK WILL BE DETOURED TO THE NORTH SIDEWALK (ON THE NON-LAKE SIDE OF ATWOOD AVENUE). THERE ARE CROSSING POINTS NEAR THE DRIVEWAY TO THE OLBRICH PARK BOAT LAUNCH AND NEAR LAKELAND AVENUE.
- VEHICLE TRAFFIC BETWEEN WALTER STREET AND OLBRICH BOTANICAL GARDENS WILL BE BIDIRECTIONAL
- THE STRETCH OF ATWOOD AVENUE BETWEEN FAIR OAKS AVENUE AND SUGAR AVENUE/OAKRIDGE AVENUE WILL REMAIN CLOSED.
- TRAFFIC TRAVELING INBOUND/TOWARD DOWNTOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE RESTRICTED TO ONE LANE FROM COTTAGE GROVE ROAD TO WALTER STREET. THERE IS NO OUTBOUND TRAFFIC FROM WALTER STREET TO COTTAGE GROVE ROAD. VEHICLES SHOULD CONTINUE USING THE POSTED DETOUR ROUTE TO TRAVEL AWAY FROM DOWNTOWN.
