- Submit required Sections A − I
- Acknowledge all Amendments



### Prequalification Application & AA Plan

- If bidding contractor is not prequalified OR does not have an approved AA Plan with the City, it must be submitted by Thursday, 03/14/24.
  - Must be approved by bid due date (03/14/2024).
- Prequals are good for 2 years and expire on March 1st of the given 2year cycle.
- AA plans are good for 2 years.
