Proposed Scope of Work

- Replace City Utilities
 Sanitary Sewer Main & Laterals
 Storm Sewer
- Replace Street Infrastructure
 Curb & Sidewalk as needed
 Resurface Asphalt Pavement
- New Sidewalk on Southside of Steensland Dr.






Utility Details

Storm Sewer

- Existing storm sewer structures and inlets to be replaced
- Extend storm sewer south to improve drainage at Hooker Ave.-Steensland Dr.
- Avoid replacing storm sewer in good condition close to mature trees
- Private storm sewer connections can be arranged
 - Cost share between City and property owner





Utility Details


Sanitary sewer

- Existing installed in 1950's
- o 8" & 10" diameter clay pipe
- Replace main with 8" & 10" diameter PVC and replace laterals to property line
- No water main work

Existing Condition of Streets

ltem	Existing Condition
Pavement Surface Evaluation & Rating	Hooker rated 4/10; Sheridan 4/10; Steensland 4/10
Curb	Hooker rated 7/10; Sheridan 7/10; Steensland 6/10
Sidewalk	Partial Sidewalk on both sides of Steensland closest to Sherman Ave, ends mid-block No sidewalk on Hooker or Sheridan
Width (curb-to-curb)	30' on Steensland & Hooker, 32' on Sheridan
Traffic Volumes/Speeds	Recent speed study showed fairly low speeds
On-street Parking	Parking allowed on both sides of all streets, except inner-edge of Steensland-Hooker bend

Proposed Street Work

- Replace curb & gutter and existing sidewalk as needed
- > Resurface Asphalt Pavement
- Replace Driveway Aprons only where curb is being replaced
 Concrete aprons remain concrete
 Asphalt aprons remain asphalt
 Gravel aprons replace with concrete






Proposed Sidewalk on Steensland

Proposed Parking Restriction on Steensland-Hooker

- Restrict Parking on Outside Bend of Steensland-Hooker
- Safety concerns, plows in winter
- Feedback?



Terrace Rain Gardens



- Collects runoff from road
 - Will help to minimize flooding impacts in smaller storms
 - Reduces nutrients going into lakes by infiltrating stormwater
- Constructed and planted by City
 - 1 foot deep (from top of curb)
 - Planted with native vegetation
- \$100 cost to residents
 - City typically pays \$3000 for construction and planting



 - Maintenance information available



Typical Terrace Rain Garden Criteria

- Terrace must be at least 10 feet wide from back of curb to edge of sidewalk
- Rain garden will be a minimum of 15 feet long
- Trees need to be at least 10 feet from edge of rain garden
- > Driveways and sidewalk ramps need to be at least 3 feet from edge of rain garden
- The rain garden needs to overflow back into the curb, away from the sidewalk/house
- The terrace cannot be too steep in either direction (lengthwise or crosswise)





Interested?

- Potential for rain gardens in terrace areas
- City can evaluate site suitability for anyone interested
- Adjacent property owner shares cost and is responsible for maintenance
- Cost to property owner is \$100

Preliminary Survey Results

- > 7 responses so far (Thank you!)
- Issues related to specific properties will be reviewed in more detail in near future
- » Survey remains open until Friday, April 16th



Forestry Information

- > Trees will be pruned prior to construction
- > Shrubs in Right-of-Way removed
- Forestry has reviewed
 - I removal due to condition: 1437 Hooker Ave (Silver Maple)
 - I removal for new sidewalk: 1501 Steensland (Honey locust)
- > Preserve trees that will remain
 - Hand formed curb
 - Curves in sidewalk
 - Bend & limits of work for sewer laterals
- Forestry will review after construction for new plantings





Construction, Access, and Impacts

- > Streets will be closed to thru traffic during construction
 - Local access maintained
 - >Driveway access for majority of project, closed for up to 3 weeks
- > Standard work hours 7AM-7PM Mon-Sat, 10AM-7PM Sun
- Any existing landscaping in the terrace will likely be disturbed
 Anything you wish to save should be removed prior to construction
- > Project may require temporary water shut-offs
- > Contractor will need to pump ground water
 - >Keep utility trenches dry and safe to complete utility work
 - >Pumps will likely need to run over night
- » Best guess construction timeframe: Aug 2021 thru Nov 2021

Private Storm Connects, if any	100%	0%
Terrace rain garden	\$100	Remainder
Sanitary Sewer Main	0%	100%
Sanitary Sewer Laterals	25%	75%
Terrace tree replacement	0%	100%



Assessment Policy & Costs

- Preliminary, estimated assessments mailed prior to project
- Final assessments calculated following construction using measured quantities and actual bid prices
 - Final billing sent in summer after construction (2022 for this project)
- Assessments are payable in lump sum or in up to 8 installments at current interest rate (2%)



Anticipated Project Schedule

- > 4/09/2021: Mail Estimated Assessments, Public Hearing Notice
- > 4/21/2021: BPW Public Hearing (held virtually)
- > 5/04/2021: Common Council Hearing (held virtually)
- > 5/20/2021: Advertise for Bids
- > 8/02/2021: Begin Construction
- > 11/12/2021: Approx. End Construction
