




# Bike Routes Map

- ▶ Goodman Path (Hoepker Rd to the Underpass 151), path passes through the Northeast Park
- ▶ Northeast Park Cyclocross (Mountain Bike Trail)
- ▶ American Parkway bike lane
- ▶ Daniel Morgan Path

# Existing Conditions


- ▶ The project is located on the Northeast Park
- ▶ Current Bike/Ped facilities:
  - Cyclocross (mountain bike trail)
  - Goodman path
- ▶ Farming grounds containing wetlands and a golf course retention pond
- ▶ A 10' easement along the ROW of Barrington IV
- ▶ Part of the park is in the Town of Burke and the City of Sun Prairie



# Proposed Design

- ▶ 10' bike path connecting Tancho Dr to the Underpass 151
- ▶ Requires tree removals within wooded areas of the park
- ▶ 10' easement on Barrington IV
- ▶ Paths lights are going to be added
- ▶ Improvement on crossing at Tancho Dr
- ▶ Avoid landscaping on Barrington IV

# Path Lighting

- ▶ Along the path
  - ▶ Safety and security
  - ▶ On all night
  - ▶ Lights near Barrington IV would be located on the south side to prevent backlight
- ▶ USSL Fixtures
  - ▶ Black bike path lighting poles

# Project Approval Schedule

- March 27, 2024: Transportation Commission
  - Engineering staff will present bike path layout for approval
- April 3, 2024: Board Park Commissioners
- April 17, 2024: Approving Plans, Specifications, and Assessments; Board of Public Works Hearing
  - Engineering staff will recommend the bike path layout for approval
- May 7, 2024: Approving Plans, Specifications, and Assessments; Common Council Public Hearing

# Construction & Access

- Allowed working hours are 7:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday-Saturday, & 10:00 am to 7:00 pm Sundays
- Coordination with parks to maintain access during construction
- Start construction mid-August 2024
  - Approximately 2 months to complete all work
- No Assessments
