



EXISTING SITE PLAN







ZONING MAP




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

PROPOSED SITE PLAN



NOTES REGARDING PREPARATION OF ESTIMATE

This estimate was prepared based on the following documents provided by Engberg Anderson Architects

1. Concept Drawings provided by Engberg Anderson Architects provided January 6, 2023
2. Design Narrative provided by Engberg Anderson Architects dated January 6, 2023
3. Information regarding the project was also obtained via meetings, phone conversations, and email messages that clarified the project scope.

BIDDING PROCESS - MARKET CONDITIONS

This document is based on the measurement and pricing of quantities wherever information is provided and/or reasonable assumptions for other work not covered in the drawings or specifications, as stated within this document. Unit rates have been generated from current material/labor rates, historical production data, and discussions with relevant subcontractors and material suppliers. The unit rates reflect current bid costs in the area. All unit rates relevant to subcontractor work include the subcontractors overhead and profit unless otherwise stated.

Pricing reflects probable construction costs obtainable in the Madison, Wisconsin area on the bid date. This estimate is a determination of fair market value for the construction of this project. It is not a prediction of low bid. Pricing assumes competitive bidding for every portion of the construction work for all subcontractors with a minimum of 3 bidders for all items of subcontracted work and a with a minimum of 3 bidders for a general contractor. Experience indicates that a fewer number of bidders may result in higher bids, conversely an increased number of bidders may result in more competitive bids.

Since Middleton Consulting has no control over the cost of labor, material, equipment, or over the contractor's method of determining prices, or over the competitive bidding or market conditions at the time of bid, this statement of probable construction cost is based on industry practice, professional experience and qualifications, and represents Middleton Consulting's best judgment as professional construction cost consultants familiar with the construction industry. However, Middleton Consulting cannot and does not guarantee that the proposals, bids, or the construction cost will not vary from opinions of probable cost prepared by them.

ASSUMED CONSTRUCTION PARAMETERS

The pricing is based on the following project parameters:

1. A construction start date of Spring 2024
2. A construction period of 14-16 months
3. The contract will be competitively bid to multiple contractors.
4. All contractors will be required to pay prevailing wages.
5. The contractors will have full access to the site during normal working hours
6. Estimate includes pricing as of January 2023





Building Systems Assessment

Programmatic Facility Study

- Completed by Engberg Anderson in 2017

 - Replace air-cooled chiller
 - Fix grading issues and foundation settlement along building perimeter

- **City of Madison anticipates a \$5M project**


PROPOSED INDOOR PROGRAM
 Proposed additional, alternate spaces are not only intended to expand programming for those specific spaces, but free up time and area for the Gymnasium and Community Rooms. Each proposed space will need additional support spaces for storage, mechanical and restrooms.

One of the proposal additional spaces would be a second or Upper Gymnasium. If this space is included in the overall building expansion the additional restroom facilities would need to be coordinated. The plan diagrams show two additional restroom areas. However, these could be consolidated if the Upper Gymnasium was constructed at this same time as other areas.

The Upper Gymnasium could also be implemented as a separate project either before or after other building expansions. The plan diagrams indicate how this could be achieved. The project budget has costs associated with either option.

The Child Care area is another alternate space which could be part of the expansion if a third party company was interested in providing these services. The Parks Division is currently not considering providing "Day Care" services.



EXPANSION SUMMARY
 Each building façade has different challenges for potential expansion. There are additional concerns with building expansion as it relates to the site. These concerns are summarized below.

SITE
 The facility does not meet a minimum parking requirement and any expansion will require additional parking. Also, the current receiving and trash area does not meet the needs of the building nor City of Madison zoning requirements. These issues would need to be addressed in any expansion. A screening fence or wall must be provided to screen the following site elements: Refuse disposal areas, outdoor storage areas, loading areas, and mechanical equipment.


Daily Pass Check-Ins by Hour


Daily Pass Check-Ins by Activity











Respondents' ZIP Codes



Please provide the information below regarding age. (Required multiple-choice)




Please provide the information below regarding race. (Required multiple-choice)


Do you feel that WPCRC is welcoming and accessible for all members of the community?


What changes are important to make WPCRC feel more welcoming and/or more accessible?


What WPCRC services/activities do you use and/or engage in most?


What services/activities do you need that are inadequate?





(Required open-ended response)




What spaces at WPCRC need improvement?



Which of the following services/activities are you most interested in? (Required multiple choice, select up to 3)


Respondents Below Age 50

Key Takeaways from Information Gathering

1. Warner Park Community Recreation Center continues to uphold the mission enacted 25 years ago when the building first opened.
2. Space use is constant throughout the day. However, programming and the spaces used are markedly different between the morning and afternoon.
3. Changes to the Center should create equitable, interactive, and multipurpose spaces with patrons of all ages and backgrounds in mind.
4. The Center needs to adapt as community needs change.
5. The current space and storage layout limits the programming that community partners can provide at the Center.
6. Changes should not preclude the future addition of a pool.





Q9 Which space below would you be most interested in? (Select 1)



 - 1. A 90'x150' gymnasium would exceed the construction budget based on the rough cost/SF numbers.
 - 2. WPCRC does not need a gymnasium this size for programming purposes.
- C. EA will proceed with the identified scope of a multipurpose gymnasium space which can also be used for classes and events, renovated bathrooms/locker rooms, and chiller replacement.
 - 1. City of Madison to verify final construction budget.
 - 2. EA to engage consultants and explore potential sites for the addition.

III. Schedule

- A. The core team will work to consolidate the design schedule so construction can begin in August 2023, allowing the contractor to build the foundation before frost.

1. Complete schematic design in December. DDs and CDs complete by May. Bid during the summer.

I. Existing Utilities

- A. Water service runs parallel to the building from the west, feeding a meter under the north mezzanine stair. Gas, electrical, telecom, and fiber optic services take the same route and enter the chiller pit. Sanitary main leaves building to the south.
 1. Keep utility locations in mind when planning expansion location.
 2. Existing utilities will not have to be upsized to accommodate the expansion.

II. Sitework

- A. JSD to set up a meeting with Bill Sullivan to discuss fire lane needs and existing conditions prior to the DAT meeting.
 1. A fire lane of some kind will likely be required. Keep fire lane as short as possible to preserve natural setting in the park. Add “hammerhead” or “bulb” at the end to allow for turnaround.
 2. Fire lane routing to be coordinated with existing grades.
 3. Additional hydrant and connection of existing watermains should only be done if required.
 4. Keep expansion height to less than 30’ above grade to avoid triggering ladder truck requirements. Expansion will not be taller than the existing structure.
- B. JSD to set up a meeting with zoning to prior to the DAT meeting to define extents of sitework improvements.
 1. Katie Bannon (kbannon@cityofmadison.com) offered as a contact.
 2. Understand what will be required for the parking lot, site lighting, and landscaping as early as possible. Make sure that zoning understands the extents of this project in relation to the park.
- C. JSD to follow up with Daniel Olivares regarding stormwater management as soon as the expansion footprint is defined.
 1. This project can disturb up to 20,000 SF. Earlier site improvements do not take away from that total.
- D. City of Madison to wrap up survey as soon as possible.

III. Expansion Options

- A. Option 1 places the new gymnasium to the north, extending the existing corridor to meet it. A small addition to the north would house storage on the first floor and mechanical equipment on the second floor (connected to the existing mezzanine).
 - 1. This option would not include an elevator. The similar scheme in the programmatic facility study included an elevator.
 - 2. PROS: Maintain existing circulation route and proximity to locker area. Utilize existing gymnasium wall for bearing load.
 - 3. CONS: Reroute utilities and find alternate location for chiller, gas meter, and transformer. Stairs required to egress at grade.
- B. Option 2 places the new gymnasium to the southeast. A new corridor is created to meet it, resulting in reconfiguration of the exercise room. A small addition to the east would house storage on the first floor (buried) and mechanical equipment on the second floor (opens to grade).
 - 1. PROS: Opportunity to create a second entry/receiving entry. Add storage when reconfiguring exercise room. Existing underground utilities remain as-is.
 - 2. CONS: More corridors in the existing center footprint.
- C. The core team prefers Option 2.
 - 1. Parks Division to review internally and see if there are any concerns not noted.

IV. Locker Room Renovation

- A. Existing bathroom/locker room footprint will be reconfigured to include (8) water closets.
 - 1. Additional fixtures required due to increased occupant load with the new gymnasium.
 - 2. Make as many restrooms single-use as possible.
- B. Remove locker rooms entirely and replace with a bank of lockers in the corridor near the gymnasiums.
- C. Provide individual shower/changing rooms separate from the other restrooms.
 - 1. Locker rooms are used very seldomly in their existing configuration.
- D. EA to look at restroom layouts for the current locker room area, keeping existing configuration and bearing wall locations in mind.

V. Pool Discussion

- A. Circle of Friends approached the Parks Division about adding scope to this expansion project to plan for the addition of a pool.
- B. Decided amongst the group that the pool should be its own project in the future. Parks Division to follow up with Circle of Friends.
- C. This expansion project will not preclude the future addition of a pool per the public information meeting takeaways. The pre-design study will note this outcome and indicate where a future pool would go in relation to the planned expansion.



Bill,

As a follow up to our meeting this morning, here are my notes:

- Team is currently exploring two options for a gymnasium addition at Warner Park's Community building
- Existing building is fully sprinkled
- Fire access will **not** be required around the existing building since it's an existing structure predating current code
- Proposed addition will not exceed 30' in height from grade
- Existing water/hydrant service throughout Warner Park is limited. Refer to GIS exhibit attached.
- Building Expansion Alt 1 (north) would require a fire access lane north of the building for 250' hose lay requirement, in addition to a hydrant from the 6" Sherman Ave service lateral to meet 500' threshold
- Building Expansion Alt 2 (southeast) would require that a hydrant be installed from the 6" Sherman Ave service lateral to meet 500' threshold, whereas the existing park loop road would serve the proposed addition for 250' hose lay. Refer to the attached exhibit showing a max hose lay of ~210' around the addition.
- Fire Dept has no concerns with hose lay/access over existing berm that is between the building and loop road
- A/E team to connect with Water Utility department for the additional hydrant off the 6" service from Sherman. I'm CC'ing Jeff Belshaw.

In conclusion, Building Expansion Alt 2 appears to be the best path forward to meet COM Fire Access requirements. A new fire access lane to the north would drastically change the character and aesthetic of the park. MEP's analysis of the existing systems may bring us back to Alt 1.

Hi Jenny and Jessica,

Thanks for meeting today to review Zoning and UDC items for the subject development. Here are my notes from today's call.

- UDC required
 - Approving body for the building expansion
 - Advisory board for landscaping
- CUP required
- If building expansion is greater than 10% of the existing building, then landscaping throughout will need to be brought up to compliance.
 - Jenny stated that the focus area can be limited. Will not need to bring full, 37-acre parcel up to code
- Site lighting would only need to be updated if touched/impacted
- Architectural expressions will want to match existing building character/materials
- Gym expansion will require a front entry presence if we intend to have visitors access from the parking lot. Drew confirmed that is the intent.
- Option 2 building expansion is preferred due to the fire access requirements needed for Option 1 (See attached exhibit)
- Preserve trees where possible.
- DAT meeting next week, then not until 1st week in January
- Merry Christmas to all!

Action Items:

- Zoning to provide JSD/Engberg with latest set of **approved** drawings
- Zoning to help JSD/Engberg define site design extents for parking lot standards. Zoning will likely want JSD/Engberg to study the parking lot immediately south of the building
 - IE: 12 contiguous stalls prior to tree island, parking counts, dimensions, etc
- Zoning to help JSD/Engberg define landscaping extents for “points” purposes.
- Zoning to check into why a CUP was needed with original building

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
