 - What current resources are on site and are more available?
 - Number of personnel
 - Hazmat-trained personnel
 - Site experts
 - Chemical experts
 - Apparatuses
 - PPE options
 - Monitoring capabilities
 - What has the fire department done since being on scene?
 - Evacuation
 - Establish zones
 - Secure perimeters
 - Rescues
