Attendees can meet their neighbors, engage with public servants, and have some fun in their neighborhood park.

THIS EVENT WILL INCLUDE A MOBILE COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC for ages 12+ with vaccine and booster options. Ages 12-17 must have parental approval to participate (this can be given over the phone).

"The goal is to provide information for local families about community services available in their neighborhood, as well as connecting youth and adults with public servants in a low-stress, pressure-less environment," said Goodman South Madison Teen Librarian Will Glenn, Sr. "It Takes A Village 2 will be bigger and better this year due to a collaboration with the City of Madison's Parks Alive! initiative. The addition of more community organizations, like the Madison Children's Museum, MAYDM, the MSCR and MMoCA Art Cart and more will really take things to the next level for attendees."
