Transportation Improvement Program

The Greater Madison MPO will conduct a public hearing on an amendment to the [2025-2029 Transportation Improvement Program](#). The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which the Greater Madison MPO updates annually, is a coordinated listing of short-range transportation improvement projects anticipated to be undertaken in the next five-year period. The TIP is the mechanism by which the long-range transportation plan is implemented and represents the transportation improvement priorities of the region.

The hearing invites comments or concerns regarding the amendment, which would revise the cost and timing of the federally funded North-South Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) construction project, as explained in the [memorandum](#).
