The Draft 2027–2031 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Madison Metropolitan Area & Dane County is now available for review and comment. The TIP lists major transportation improvements and studies anticipated to be undertaken during the next five-year period.

The draft TIP is available on the MPO's [TIP webpage](#). This year, the MPO has also launched a new electronic TIP (eTIP), allowing project listings to be viewed either in PDF format or through the new interactive [eTIP website](#).

As part of the TIP process, we are notifying local units of government of projects for which implementing agencies intend to request federal funding assistance. If you have comments or concerns regarding federally funded projects or any other projects listed in the draft TIP, please submit them in writing by **Monday, September 21**. Written comments may be mailed to the MPO office or emailed to MPO staff at mpo@cityofmadison.com. Comments may also be submitted directly on individual project listings through the interactive eTIP website.

A virtual public hearing on the draft TIP will also provide an opportunity to provide oral comments to the MPO Policy Board. MPO staff are available to answer questions, discuss projects, and receive comments throughout the public comment period.
