


Why now?

 Recover from COVID-19 in a way that reflects future needs


 Compliments BRT and brings some of those benefits to more neighborhoods






Basic Goals for Public Transportation

• Ridership concentrates transit service onto fewer routes with more frequent service, ultimately increasing ridership




 Coverage extends transit service to as many people as possible regardless of frequency




Policy Direction

- 1. Ridership, definitely. Minor corrections only.
- 2. Ridership, mostly. Some lower frequencies to reach a few more places.
- 3. Coverage, mostly. Just a little less coverage to so we can get a few higher frequencies.
- 4. Coverage, definitely. Minor corrections only.


Bus Stops

 Generally, bus routes will serve bus stops that exist along the corridors

 Along University and Johnson, local and BRT bus stops will need to be coordinated. Metro Transit is working to determine where those stops should be and how they function.



Campus Routes 80, 81, 82, and 84



Campus Routes 80, 81, 82, and 84

 No changes with the Transit Network Redesign, but Metro works closely with the UW to identify changes.

Route 81 will need to be rerouted off of Lower State Street.

• Primary concern is capacity on Route 80.


How far can I travel in 45 minutes from


