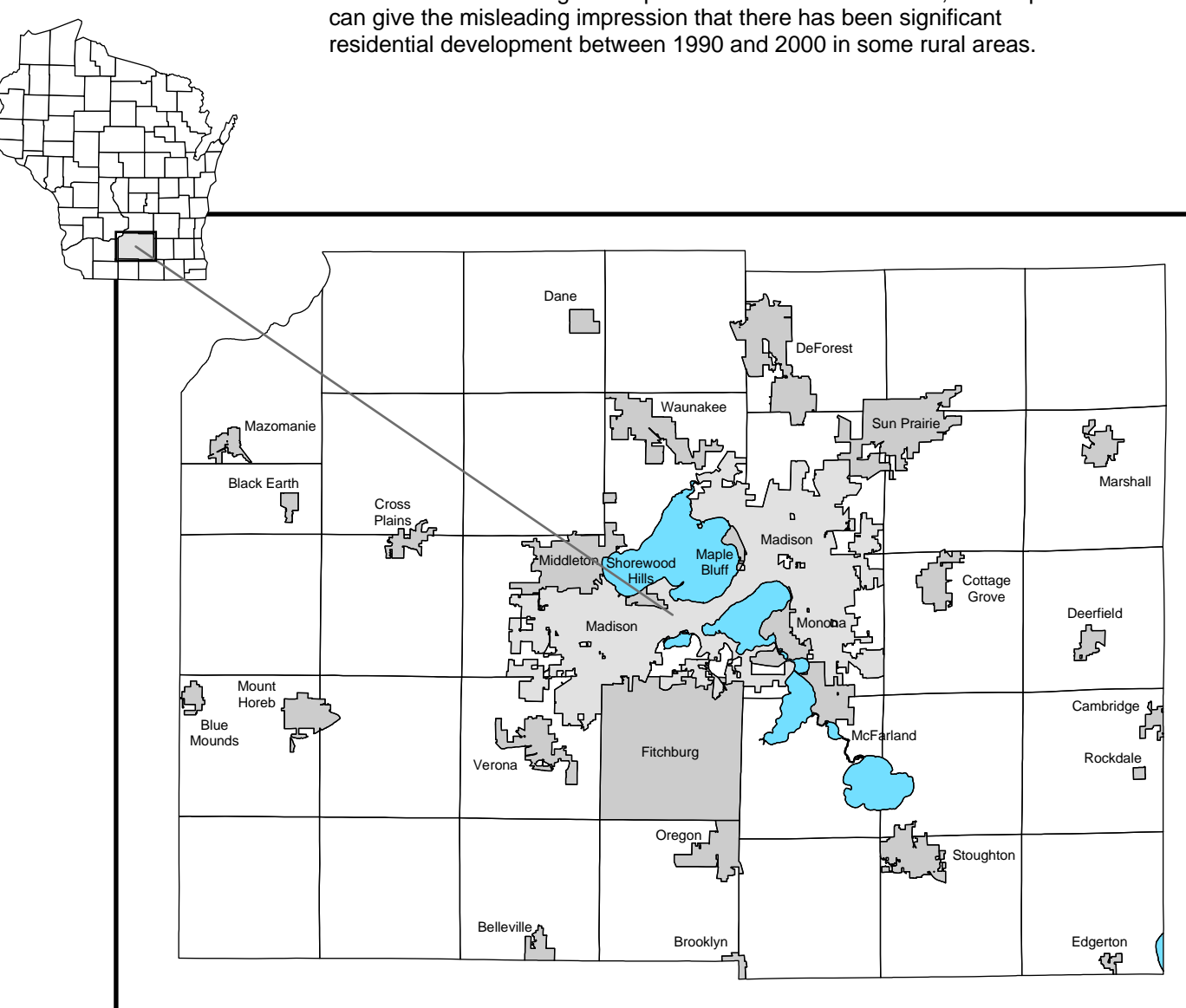

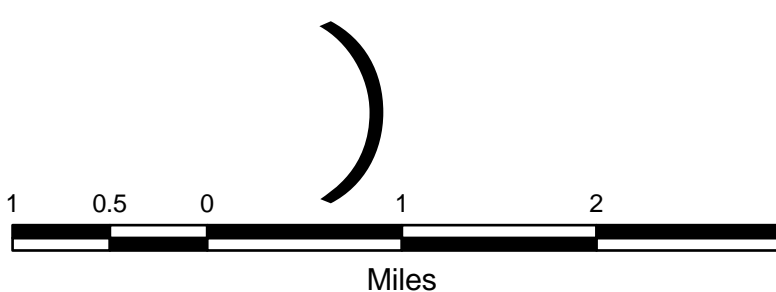

*Note: The 1990 and 2000 Land Use data models are slightly different. The most noteworthy is that residential land use was not inventoried at the parcel level for most rural residential areas of Dane County in 1990 - only point locations were collected. When comparing 1990 and 2000 land use, as this map does, a gray dot appearing on a residential parcel indicates it was existing development as of 1990. Therefore, this map can give the misleading impression that there has been significant residential development between 1990 and 2000 in some rural areas.
