



ATTACH PERMIT IN LOWER LEFT HAND CORNER OF THE INSIDE WINDSHIELD (DRIVER'S SIDE).

The Madison Police Department may issue a ticket if:

- Permit is improperly displayed
- Permit is unreadable
- More than one permit is displayed
- License plate or vehicle does not match the permit information in the City's permit database.

DON'T TOSS YOUR PERMIT!

If the permit is lost, you may be ineligible to purchase another permit until the next permit year.

You MUST surrender your permit to purchase a replacement permit (\$11.00) if your:

-  Address changes (including changing permit areas) or lease extension at same address
-  Vehicle is Sold
-  Vehicle is junked
-  Vehicle is exchanged or swapped with another
-  Windshield is replaced
-  License Plate Number Changes (including temporary plate number changes)

WHAT YOUR RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT DOES NOT DO:

- **DOES NOT** exempt you from other parking regulations (i.e. street sweeping and garbage collection). You are only exempt from 1 or 2 hour parking restrictions in your area.
- **DOES NOT** allow parking in excess of 48 hours.
- **DOES NOT** exempt you from winter alternate side parking regulations (enforced Nov. 15 – March 15).
- **DOES NOT** guarantee you a parking place.
- **DOES NOT** apply to metered parking spaces.
