## Features State of Art Equipment

All members and guest are required to change into appropriate gym shoes before entering the fitness center. Please feel free to change in the locker rooms. No food or beverages are allowed in the fitness center. Water bottles ok. Frequently used machines may have time limits.

Youth 12-15 years old are required to attend an equipment orientation class (\$15 fee) explaining proper use of the equipment before they are allowed to use the fitness center. Youth under 12 are not allowed in the fitness center at any time.
