- Development of a master plan document that has received input from a broad cross section of the residents of Madison.
- The master plan document will be a framework plan that will inform future budget requests to identify projects that will go through additional public engagement and design development processes.
- A master plan report that meets the expectations of the approved Park Master Plan Policy.
- To present a vision for Vilas Park that will help to inform development decisions over the next 15-20 years.

Site Observations & Intercept Interviews

4 park observations & intercept interview sessions per month

- **19** park observations conducted
- 1,149 individual activities observed
- **32** intercept interviews conducted
- 10 parking counts conducted

Parking Counts

2-3 parking counts per month (11 parking lots and 6 streets total)

- Before and after 8 am & 5 pm peak, and at Noon
- **13** parking counts conducted to date
