



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Acewood Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1960. While some improvements have been made, the park has been in its current configuration since around 1995.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, basketball court, sun shelter, drinking fountain and a park path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed facilities include additional managed meadow, outdoor exercise equipment, and a new walking path with connections to the existing basketball court and sun shelter.
