1. Site Conditions

- Existing equipment **at least 28** years old. Acquired by the city in 2022.
- All existing equipment and pea gravel surfacing will be removed
- Playground footprint to be combined into 1 area

2. Proposed Age Range of Play Structure

- Park has **5** playgrounds within 1 mile of the park
- Can get playground elements in a 5-12 playground that are ground elements suitable for ages 2-5
