Introduction

Orlando Bell Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1978. Some improvements have been made to Orlando Bell Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 2000.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, shelter, basketball court, backstop, horseshoe pits, drinking fountain, engineering path, and a park path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed amenities include a new park path and additional managed meadow.
