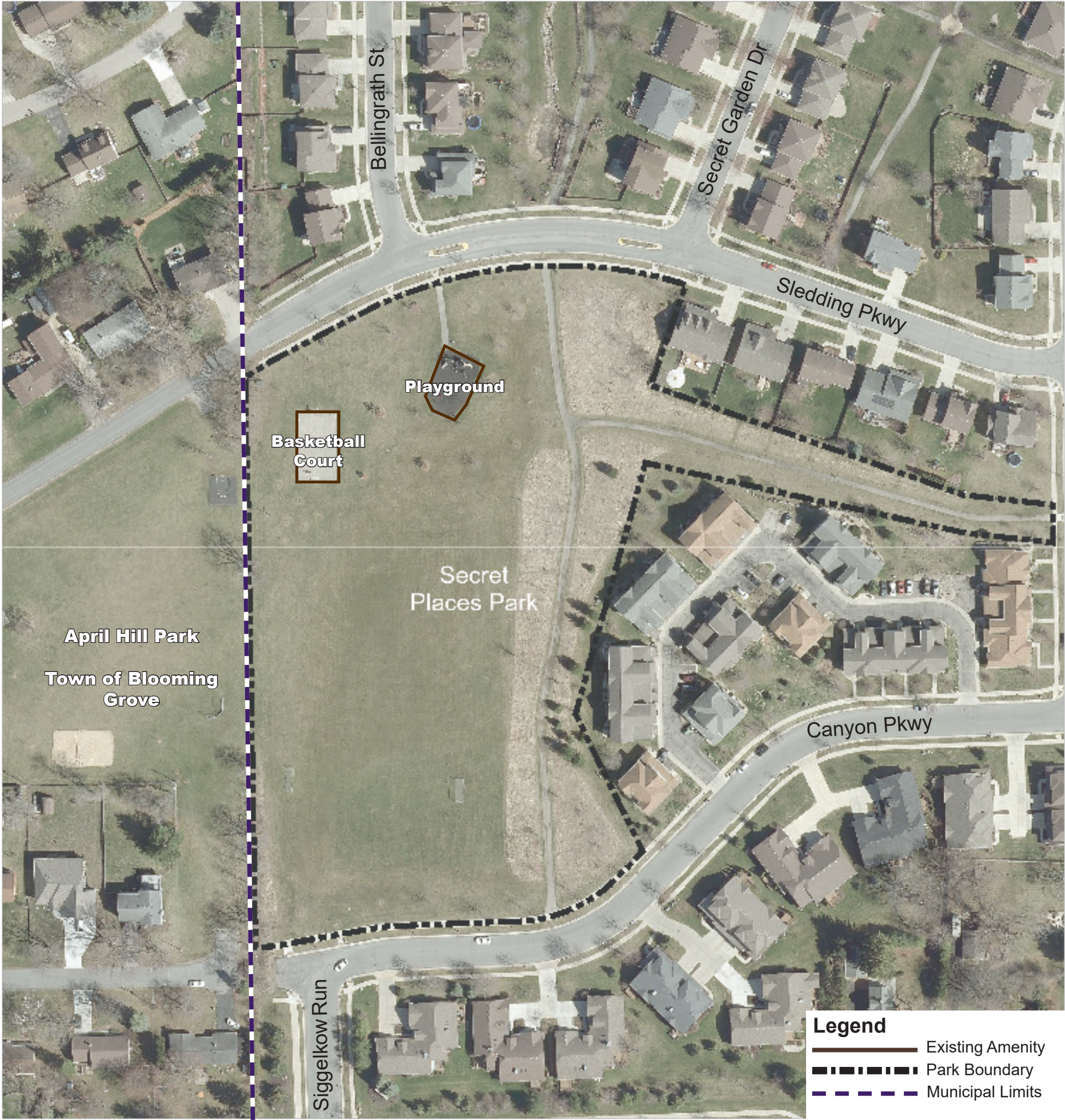




Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

Secret Places Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 2004. Some improvements have been made to Secret Places Park, but the park has remained in its current configuration since around 2007.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground and a basketball court. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

At this time, no changes are proposed.

Special Conditions

Secret Places Park is adjacent to April Hill Park, property of the Town of Blooming Grove. Per the City of Madison Town of Blooming Grove Cooperative Plan, the City of Madison will attach April Hill Park on October 31, 2027. When this land is officially attached to the City of Madison, Madison Parks will create a holistic Park Development Plan for the entire area.
