



Park Development Plan Summary

Introduction

O.B. Sherry Park is part of the Southeast Area Plan and was acquired by the City in 1974. Some improvements have been made to O.B. Sherry Park with the playground being replaced in 2019.

Existing Facilities

Existing park facilities include a playground, shelter, backstop, engineering paths and a park path. Existing amenities should be kept on typical maintenance and replacement schedules.

Proposed Facilities

Proposed facilities include a new sun shelter, new community patio with games, and a new signature park sign with landscaping enhancements in the NE corner of Milwaukee and Leon St.

Special Conditions

Unimproved Willow St. road right of way through center of park. 12’ sanitary easement in Northeast corner of park. Interest in acquiring two residential properties next to NE property boundary, upon which a holistic plan will be created for the northern half of the park.
