Madison Parks System

- The development and operations of the Madison Parks System is guided by the Parks and Open Space Plan
 - The 2025-2030 Park and Open Space Plan is expected to be adopted by the Common Council in October of 2025.
- Madison Parks ranked 19th out of the 100 largest cities in the US in the 2024 Trust for Public Land ParkScore
 - Ranked highly in Amenities and Access
 - Ranked 72nd in Investment per capita

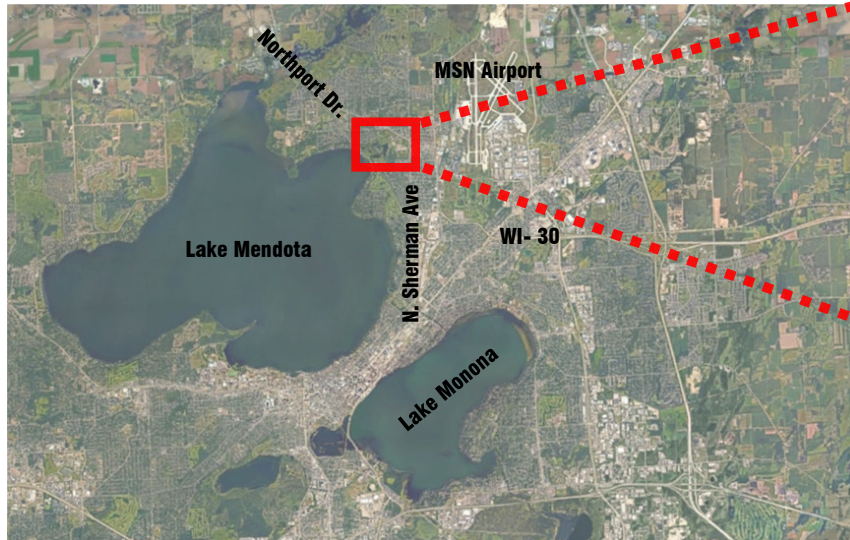

SE Plan Overview

Create space that allows for a multitude of uses

- This will allow Parks more flexibility to adapt to changing recreational trends over time

Provide paved path connectivity throughout the project area to provide better connections to the rest of Warner Park

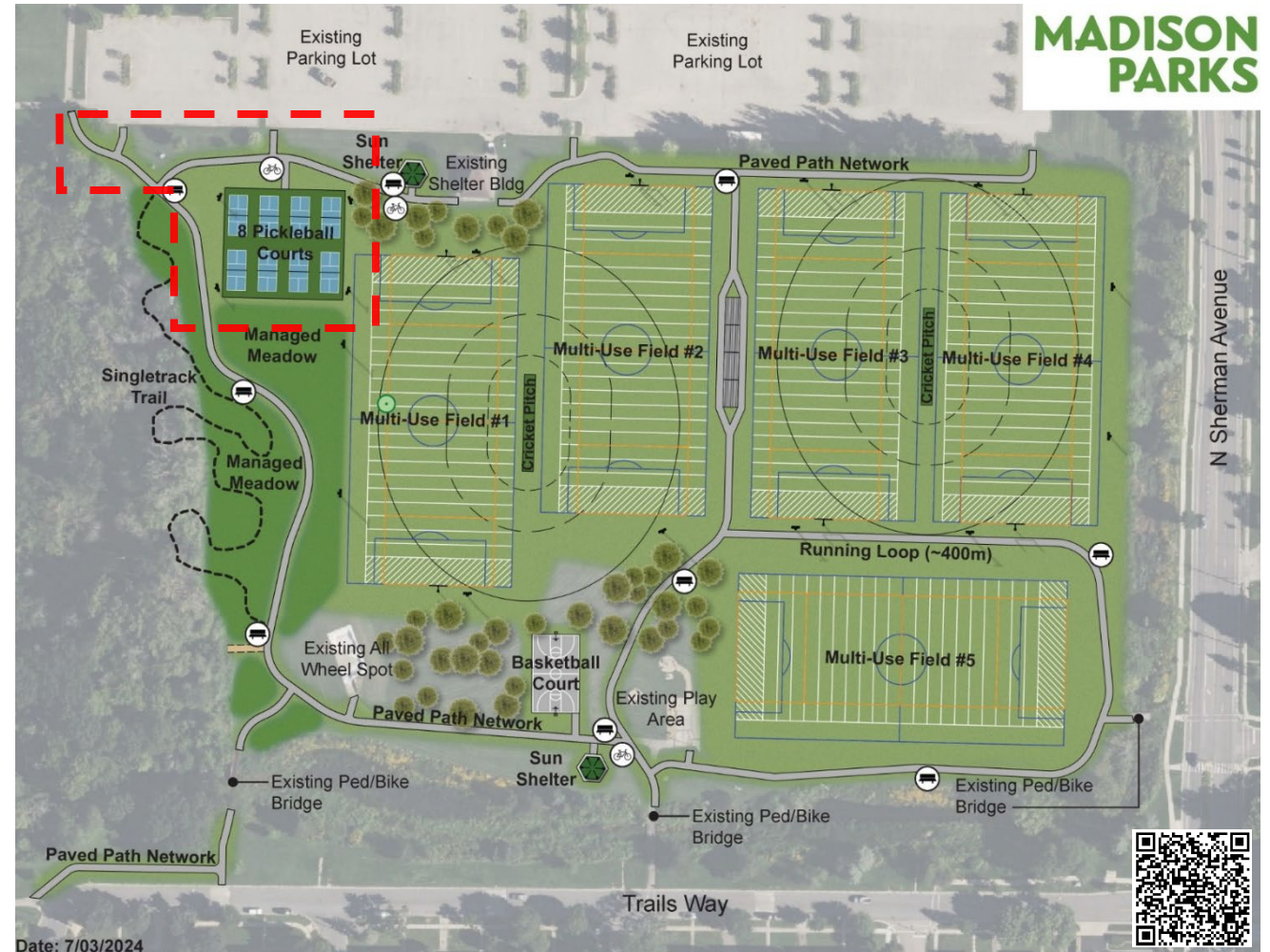
Replace existing lighting system to modernize and re-locate poles to allow for full-size rectangular field alignments

Enhance “neighborhood park” area for residents near Trailway

P H A S E 1

Add dedicated Pickleball court area on the North/East side.

- Only current dedicated court area is located at Garner Park on the West side
- Existing tennis courts are in poor condition and will be removed. The area will be restored to natural area

Design Overview

Construction of 8 dedicated pickleball courts

- Including fencing, gates, seating, and windscreens

New paved multi-use paths to increase area accessibility and access to the courts

Reuse of current lighting until future phase

Removal of tennis courts (off plan) and restoration of area to native vegetation

Removal of softball backstop

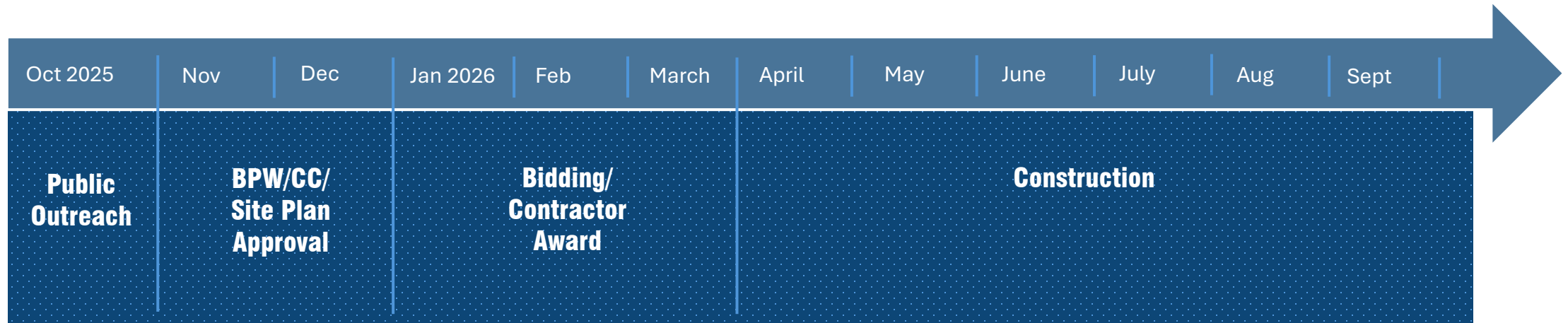
