Madison General Ordinances state that there is no parking any time on Millpond Road beginning 269 feet west of Savannah and continuing eastward. Millpond beyond 269 feet to the west of the intersection with Savannah is in the town of Blooming Grove, and is not under City of Madison jurisdiction, according to my records.

Madison General Ordinances state there is no parking on both sides of Savannah Road from Highway 12 & 18 to Millpond road, and from a point 1240 feet west of Millpond Road to Evan Acres Road. So there is a portion of Savannah where parking is allowed south of the Millpond intersection, with parking restrictions further to the south.

Madison General Ordinances state there is no parking at any time on Long Dr., however the sign inventory does not show any signs indicating this. If there are no signs posted on Long Dr. we should have the sign shop install no parking any time signs on Long Dr. Long Dr. is a narrow street (24') so if people park on both sides, especially in the winter, this could be problemmatic.
