The one-lot certified survey combining your client's property located at 2635 University Avenue, Section 21, Township 7N, Range 9E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The site is zoned TSS (Traditional Shopping Street District). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied before final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Janet Dailey of the City Engineering Division at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following six (6) conditions:

- 1. Reconcile the typographical error on Sheet 1: Basis of bearings text cites "Assumbed" instead of "Assumed".
- 2. Reconcile erroneous parcel square footage in the Surveyor's Certificate. CSM currently shows the square footage as: containing 70,100 square feet, 1.61 acres.
- 3. The site investigation on the property closed with residual groundwater contamination above Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources standards. The applicant shall provide an assessment of the risk of vapor intrusion to the future building. Contact Brynn Bemis with questions, 608-267-1986.
- 4. A minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff on the CSM, the applicant shall contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).
- 5. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) and City of Madison sanitary sewer connection charges are due and payable prior to City Engineering Division sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's/ Subdivision Contract. Contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff.
- 6. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The developer's surveyor and/or applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in

this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering Division. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office. The applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the plat or CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.

Please contact Dennis Cawley of the Madison Water Utility at 261-9243 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

7. Note: This property is in wellhead protection district WP-6. This use is permitted in this district. Any proposed change in use shall be approved by the Water Utility General Manager or his designee. Per MGO Section 13.21, all wells located on this property shall be abandoned if no valid well operation permit has been obtained from the Madison Water Utility.

Please note that the City's Office of Real Estate Services is reviewing the report of title provided with this survey and may have comments. That office will send any comments to you by fax or e-mail. If you have any questions, please contact Jenny Frese at 267-8719 for more information. The owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final signoff is requested. The survey shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division is scheduled for approval by the Common Council on <u>July 16, 2013</u>.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. E-mail submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to <u>epederson@cityofmadison.com</u>.

Upon acceptance and recording of the certified survey map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in six (6) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
