SUBJECT: 1000 OAKS -702 South Point Rd.

The City of Madison Fire Department (MFD) has reviewed the subject development and has the following comments:

MAJOR OR NON-STANDARD REVIEW COMMENTS (Comments which are special to the project and/or may require additional work beyond a standard, more routine project.)

Provide fire apparatus access as required by Comm 62.0509 and MGO 34.19, as follows: Provide a fire lane with the minimum clear unobstructed width of 20-feet.
Information: P-37,36,35,20,19,5 are served by a 26 foot fire lane. No on street parking will be allowed on this access, 26 feet – 8 feet parking = 18 foot fire lane in these locations, or increase access lane to 28 feet and one side can have parking.

GENERAL OR STANDARD REVIEW COMMENTS

In addition, we offer the following General or Standard Review Comments:

- 2. All portions of the exterior walls of newly constructed one- and two-family dwellings shall be within 500-feet of at least one fire hydrant. Distances are measured along the path traveled by the fire truck as the hose lays off the truck. See MGO 34.20 for additional information.
- 3. Where there is a change in the direction of a fire lane, the minimum inside turning radius shall be at least 28-feet.
