- Landscape Plan (including planting schedule depicting species name and planting size)
- Building Elevation Drawings (fully dimensioned drawings for all building sides, labeling primary exterior materials)
- Floor Plans (fully dimensioned plans including interior wall and room location)

## Provide collated project plan sets as follows:

Authorizing Signature of Property Owner

- Seven (7) copies of a full-sized plan set drawn to a scale of 1 inch = 20 feet (folded or rolled and stapled)
- Twenty Five (25) copies of the plan set reduced to fit onto 11 X 17-inch paper (folded and stapled)
- One (1) copy of the plan set reduced to fit onto 8 ½ X 11-inch paper
- \* For projects requiring review by the **Urban Design Commission**, provide **Fourteen (14) additional 11x17 copies** of the plan set. In addition to the above information, <u>all</u> plan sets should also include: 1) Colored elevation drawings with shadow lines and a list of exterior building materials/colors; 2) Existing/proposed lighting with photometric plan & fixture cutsheet; and 3) Contextual site plan information including photographs and layout of adjacent buildings and structures. The applicant shall <u>bring</u> samples of exterior building materials and color scheme to the Urban Design Commission meeting.
