The congregation of Mount Olive Lutheran Church (MOLC) of 110 Whitney Way would like to indicate their intent to take down the house/structure on their property, currently listed with the address of 105 Merrill Crest Drive. This structure is currently uninhabitable due to years of dormancy and lack of upkeep. MOLC currently has no use for this structure and does not have any plans for its use in the future. This structure is currently an eyesore for the neighborhood and attraction for rodents. MOLC would like to accomplish the demolition of the structure utilizing a controlled burn by the Madison Fire Department (MFD). In the way, the community could benefit by providing a training site for MFD recruits. This burn would hopefully take place later this year.
