WATER FACILITIES

Gravity and direct pressure system of water works owned by the city. Installed 1882. Stand pipe 12 ft. diam. Capacity 53,000 galls. gives minimum pressure of 57 lbs. at pump house. Cut-off valve near stand pipe for direct pressure. Reservoir at pump house with capacity of 136,000 galls. another to be built of one million galls. capacity.
One Atlas pump, capacity three million galls. and two Knowles pumps, capacity of one 1/2 million galls. and the other 2 1/2 million galls.
Primary water supply from 10 artesian wells.
481 miles of water pipes, 4" to 16" diam. (mostly 4" & 6") 132 Double hydrants. Domestic pressure 40 to 70 lbs. Average daily consumption 1 1/2 million galls. 8 fire cisterns.
