

Inclusionary Dwelling Unit Plan 30 Condominium units 2425 Jeffy Trail May 23, 2007

- 1. Project Narrative:
 - a. General Character of the Intended Development: This project is located at 2425 Jeffy Trail. The property is currently zoned R4 and is approximately 230,844 square feet in area. The development proposal envisions new owner-occupied condominiums for the professional and empty-nester market. The proposed buildings are one story with a total of 30 condominium units. The development will include garage and surface parking with an overall parking ratio of 2.26 stalls per unit.

PART 5 – INCENTIVES: Section 28.04 (25) of the Zoning Ordinance provides the opportunity for applicants in projects where affordable dwelling units are required or where the developer has agreed to pay money in lieu of inclusionary dwelling units, to receive one or more incentives as compensation for complying with the Inclusionary Zoning requirements. Each of the eleven incentives listed below are affixed a point value. The incentive points available to an applicant is dependent upon the number of affordable dwelling units proposed at the various area median income (AMI) levels. The program rewards projects both for having a higher number of affordable dwelling units provided at lower AMI levels, and for having a higher percentage of affordable dwelling units incorporated into the development. PART 6 - WAIVER: The Plan Commission may waive the requirement to provide inclusionary dwelling units in the development if the applicant can present clear and convincing financial evidence that providing the required number of inclusionary dwelling units on-site renders providing the required number of inclusionary units financially infeasible. In such a case, a developer may request a waiver to provide the units off-site, assign the obligation to provide the units to another party, or pay cash in lieu of the units, or any combination of the above. If the waiver is granted, the required units may be provided as new construction off-site in another development within **one mile** of the subject development; off-site units shall be provided at least 1.25 times the number of units if provided within the subject development. Off-site units must be constructed within one year of the time that they would have been constructed within the subject development. The applicant may opt to pay money into the Inclusionary Unit Reserve Fund based on contribution rates established in Section 28.04 (25) of the Zoning Ordinance. If provision of the inclusionary dwelling units through the waiver is still financially infeasible, the developer may seek a reduction in the percent of units to the point where the project becomes financially feasible. If such a waiver is requested, a detailed explanation shall be provided in the required project narrative demonstrating the financial infeasibility of complying with the ordinance requirements and the rationale for the alternative proposed.

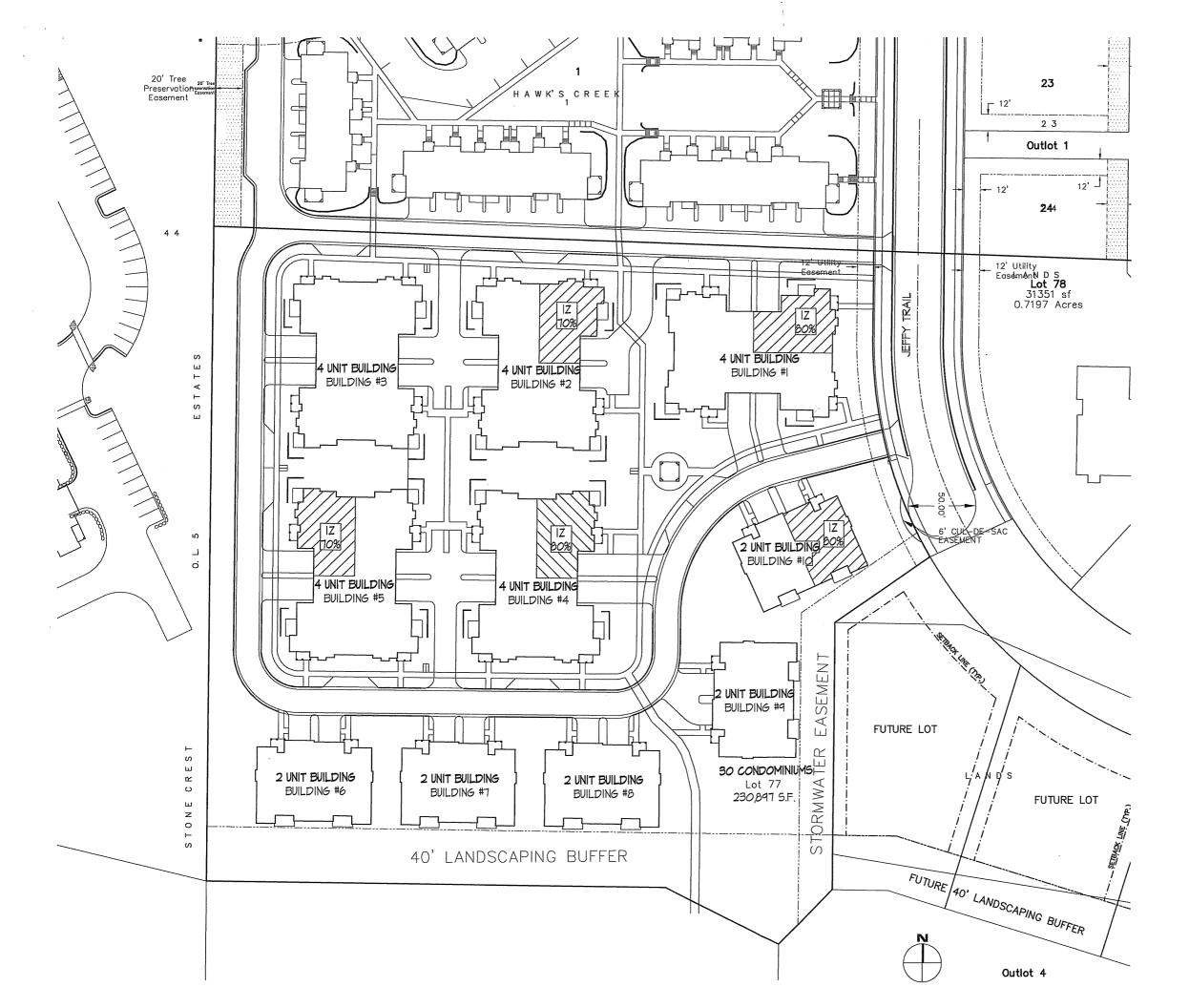

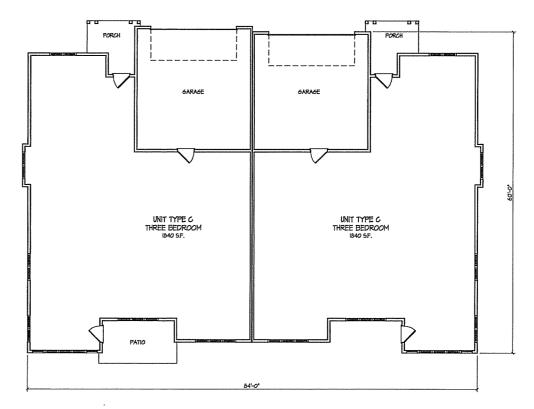

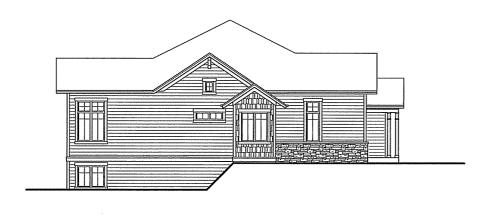
