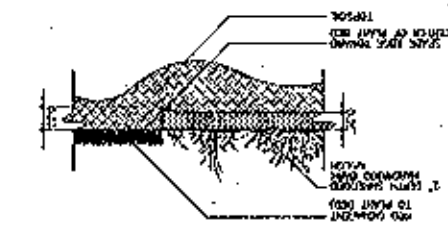
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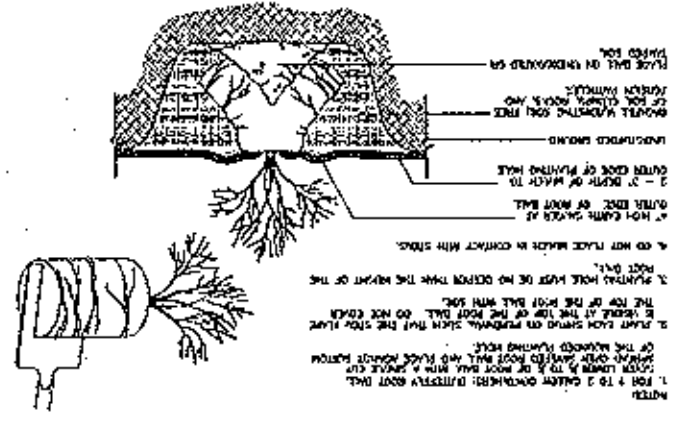
2 DIMENSION OF PLANT SPACING DETAIL



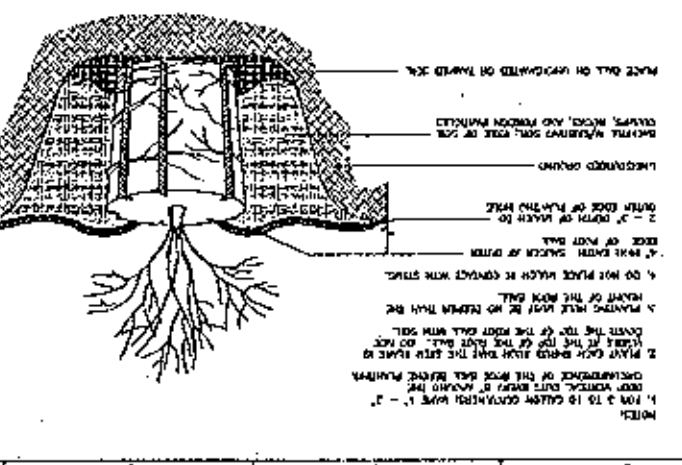

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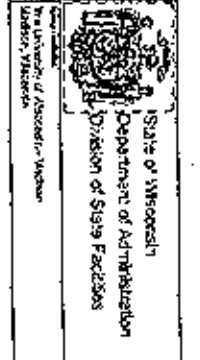


1 Light Trespass Calculations Plan

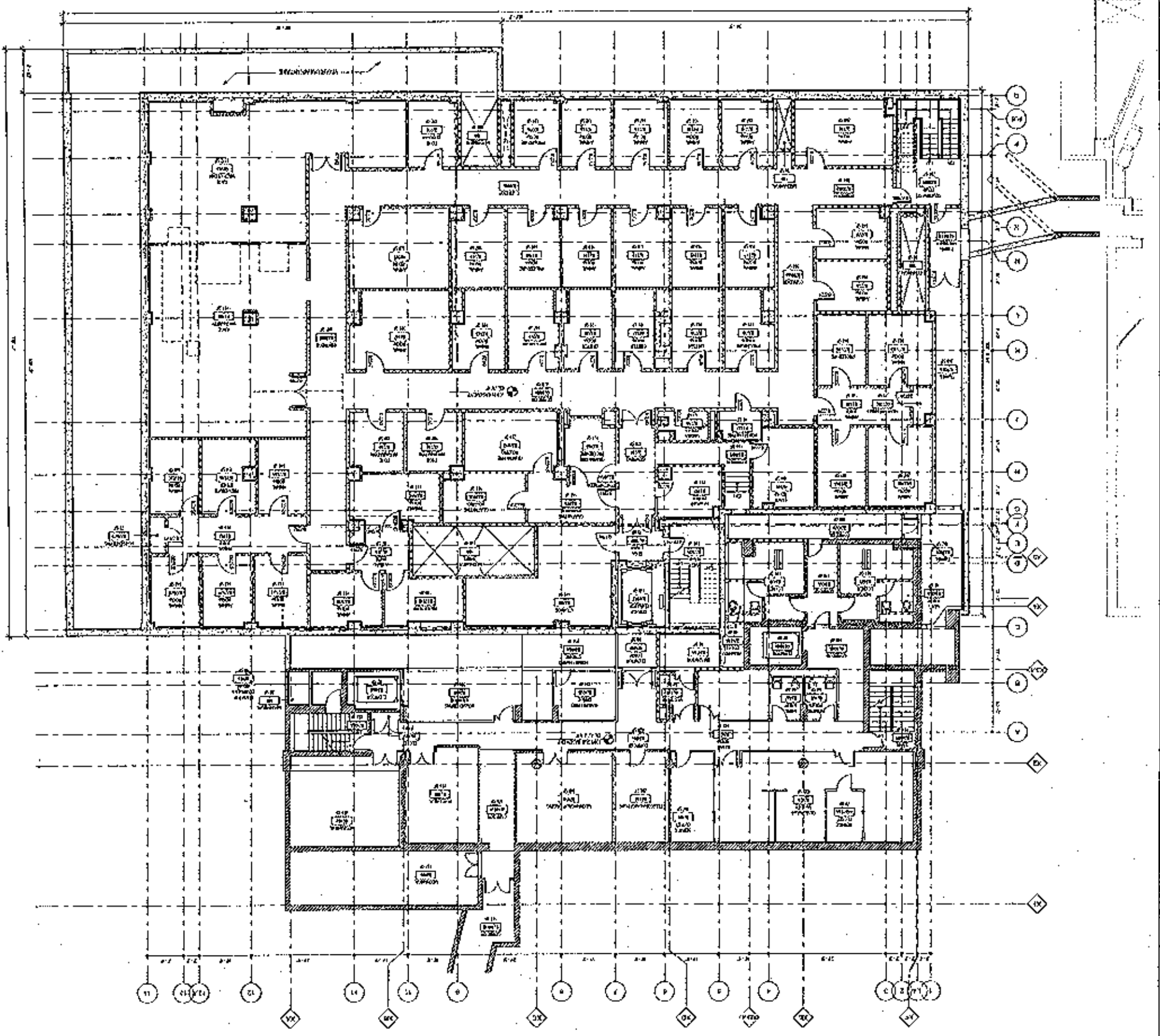
A8 2010N - PLUMBING MEZZANINE FLOOR PLAN

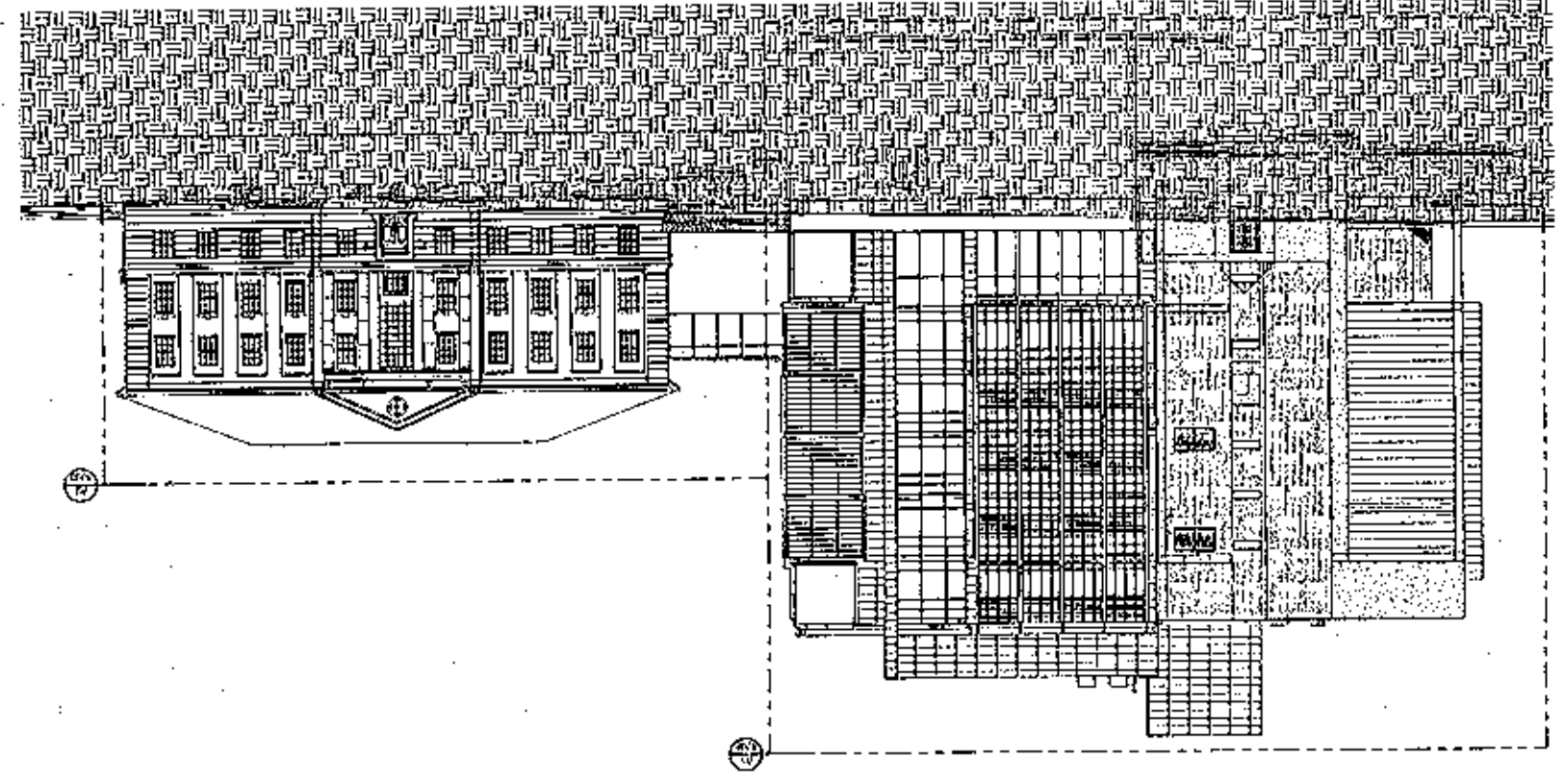


A1 2010N - PENTHOUSE ROOF & ELEVATOR MACHINE ROOM PLAN

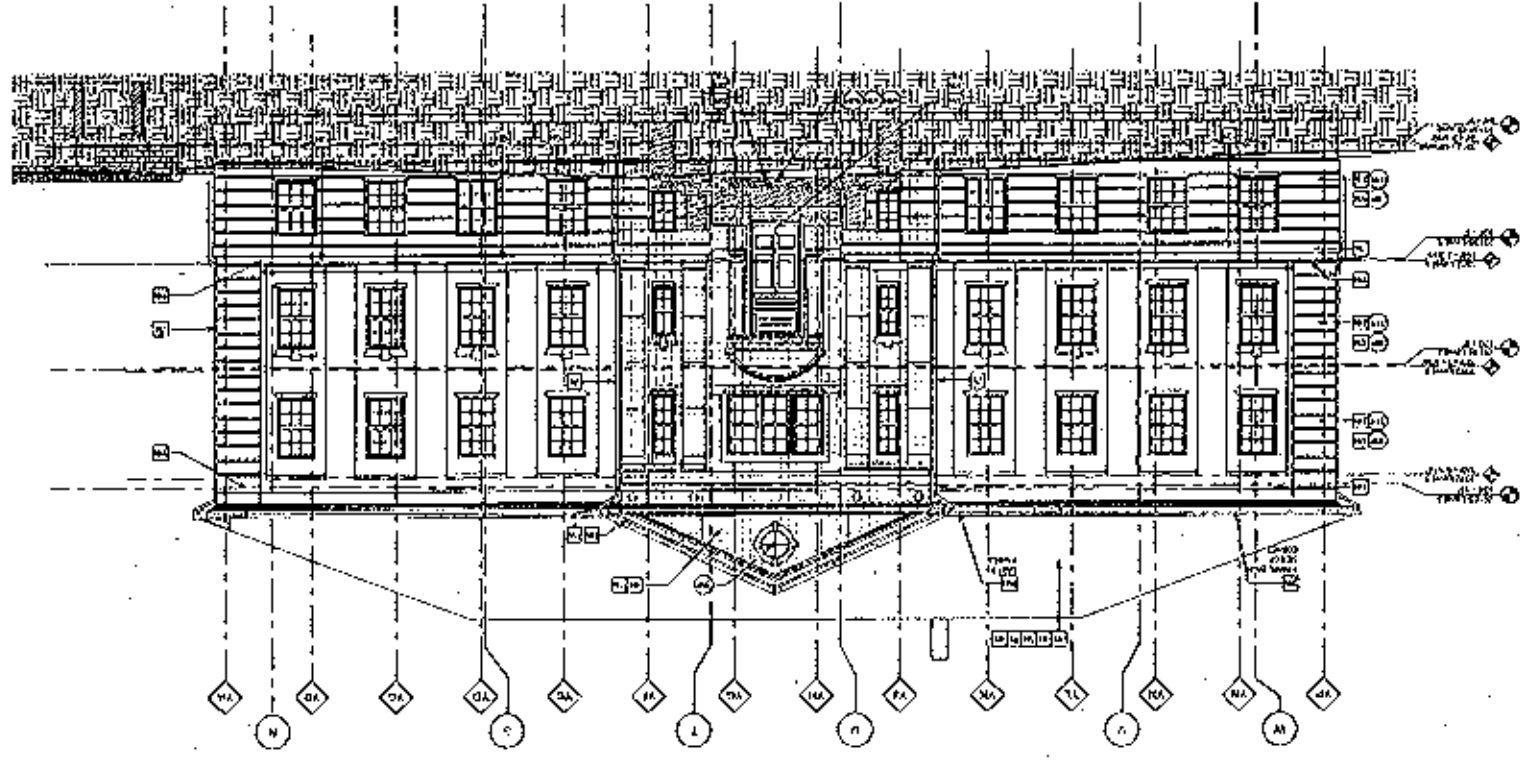
F2 EXTERIOR OVERALL ELEVATION - SOUTH

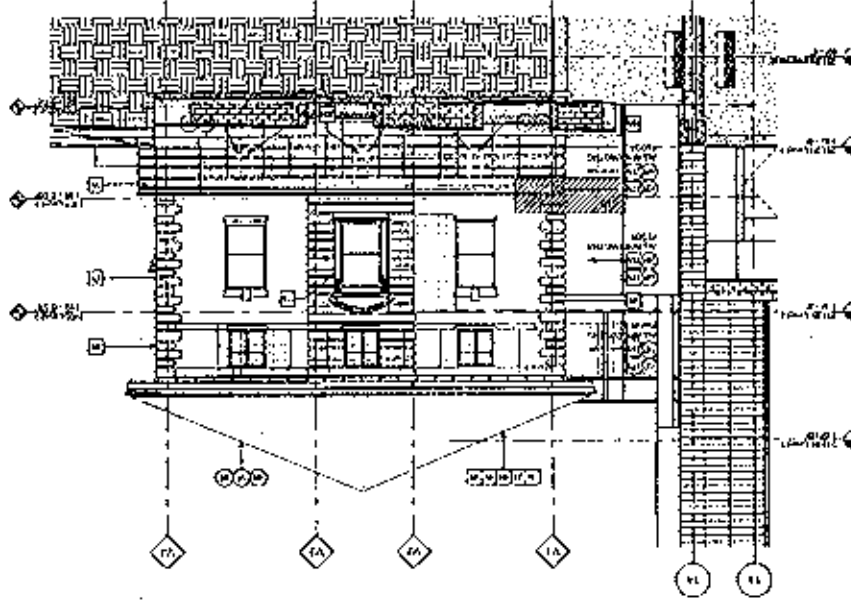
A1 EXTERIOR ELEVATION - 1906 - NORTH



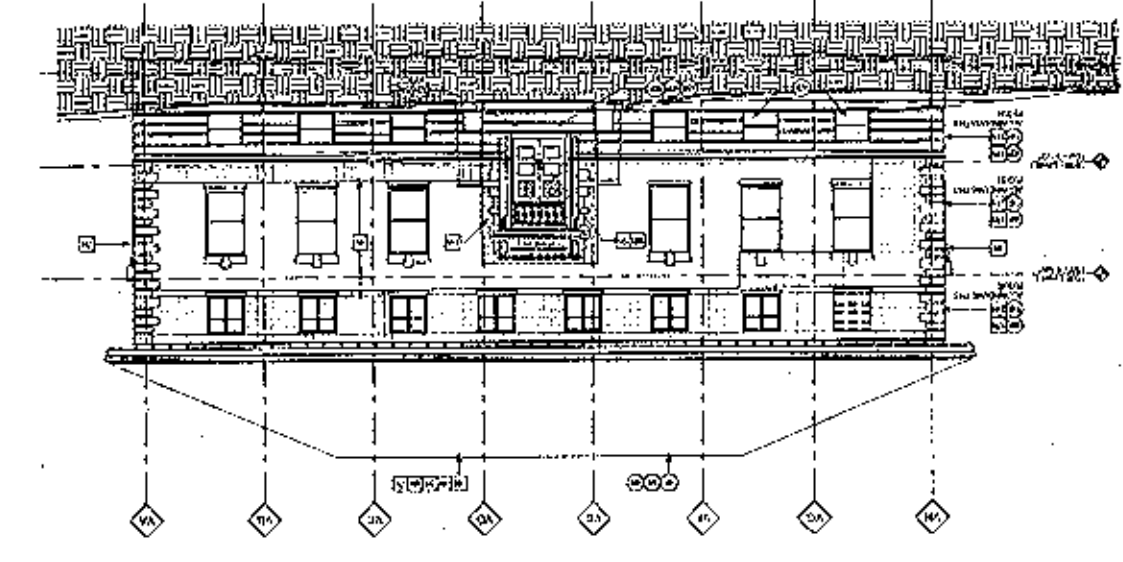
A5 EXTERIOR ELEVATION - 1906 - WEST
