The 720 square foot house at 1010 Northport Dr. has already been stripped of most reusable/recyclable items. All cabinets, trim, appliances, interior doors, electrical fixtures, counters, sinks, toilets, gutters, dounspouts, HVAC equipment and water heater have been removed. Roof leaks have led to unusable framing wood, siding and windows. Frank Byrne at the Restore [10/14/09] said they could use nothing. The asphalt driveway has deteriorated almost to rubble. Over half of the existing foundation is four foot frost walls. This and the other section of pored concrete basement will be recycled ar Wingra Stone. If there is anything else to consider please let me know.
