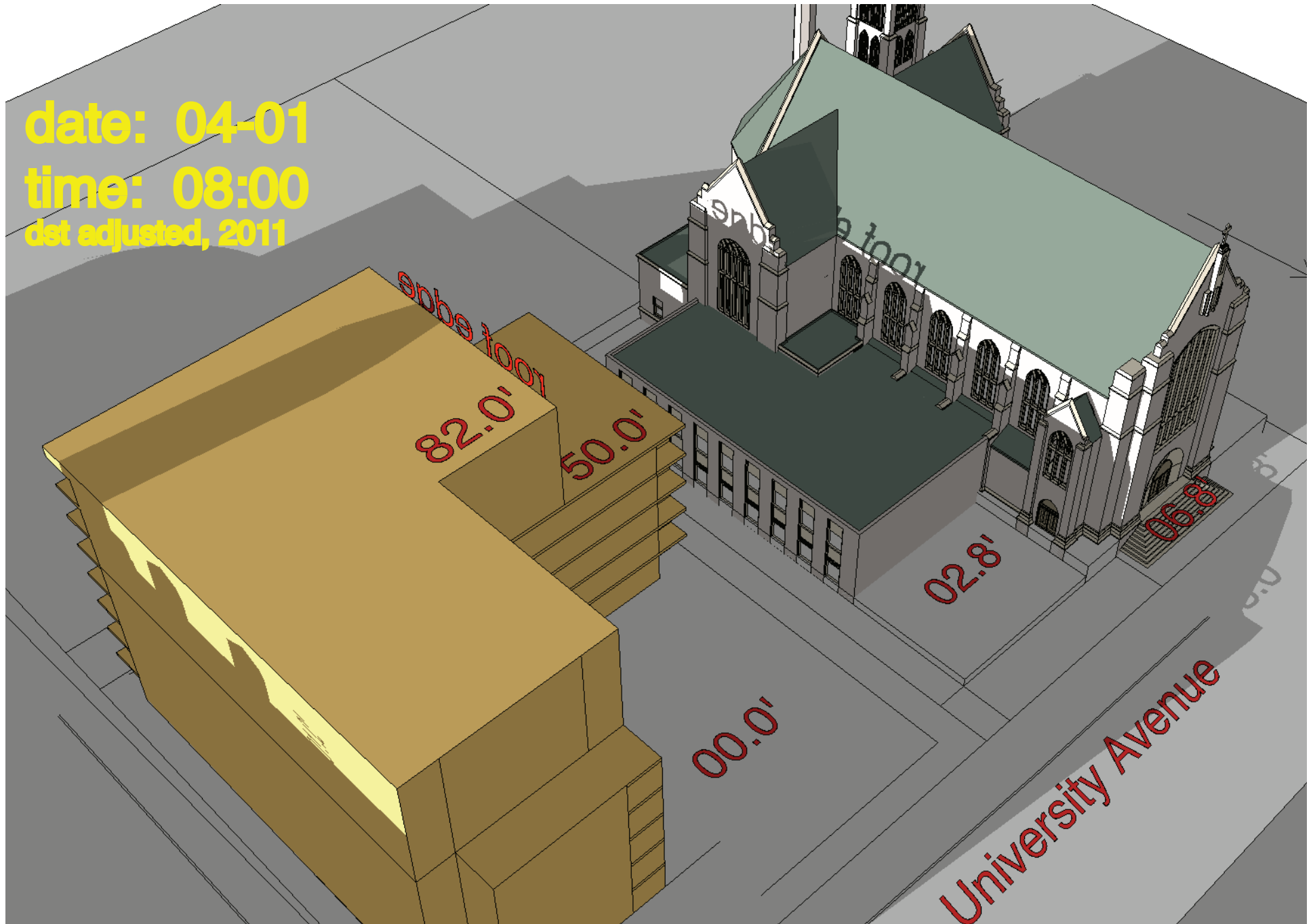

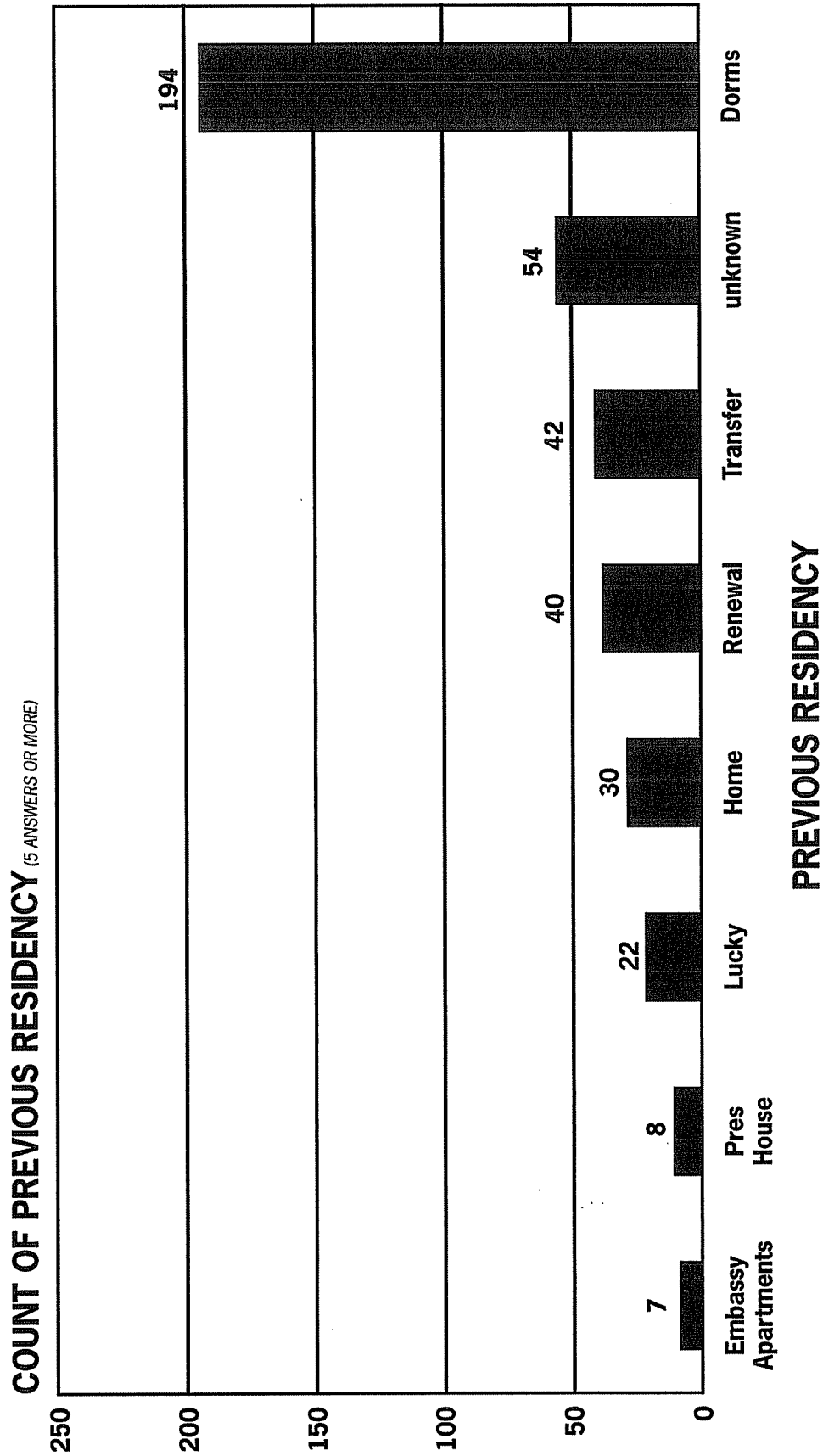

T Transept window

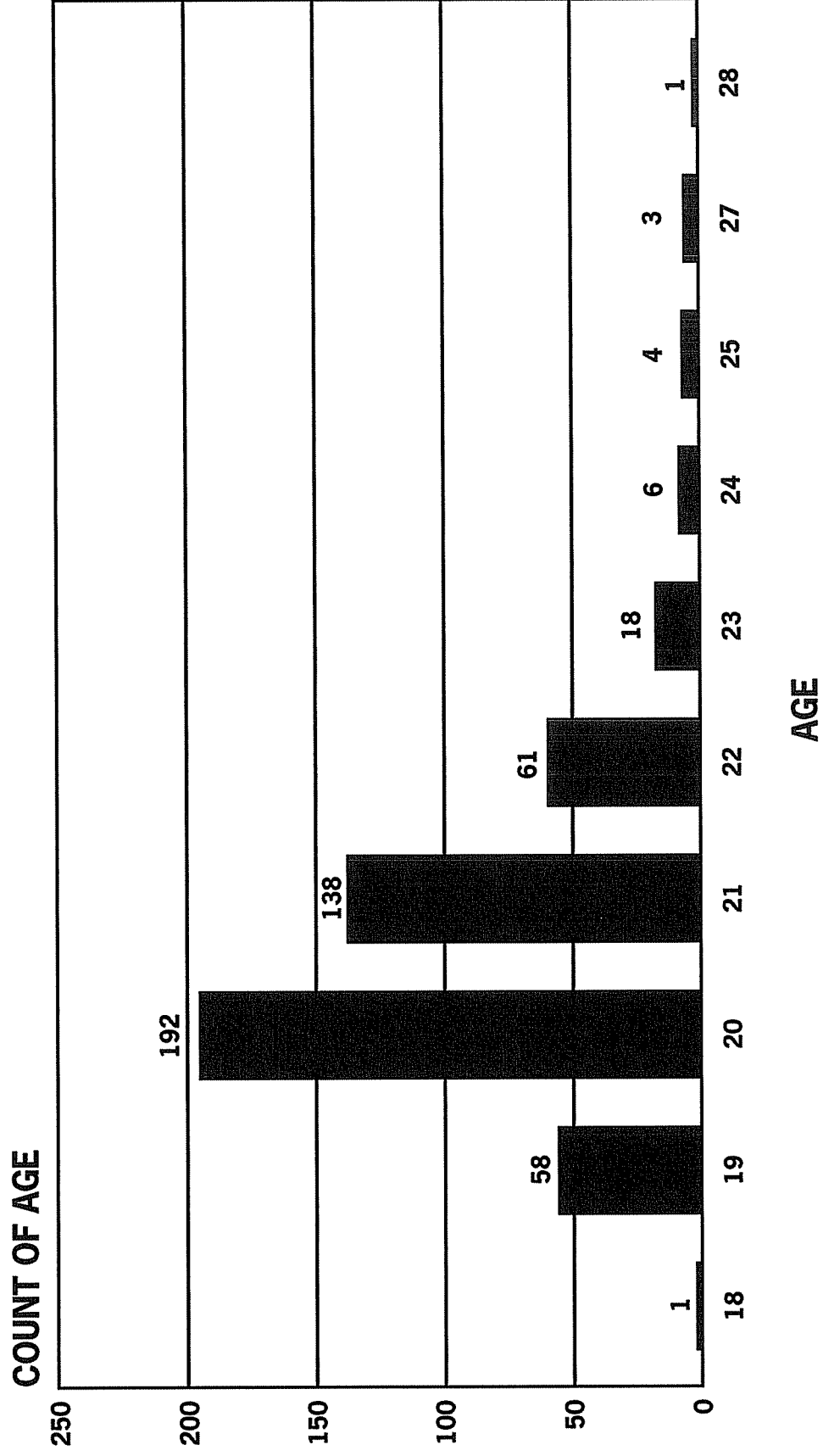
1 thru 5 east Nave windows, numbered from south to north

TOTAL NUMBER OF PERSONS CURRENTLY AT GRAND CENTRAL BY PREVIOUS RESIDENCY

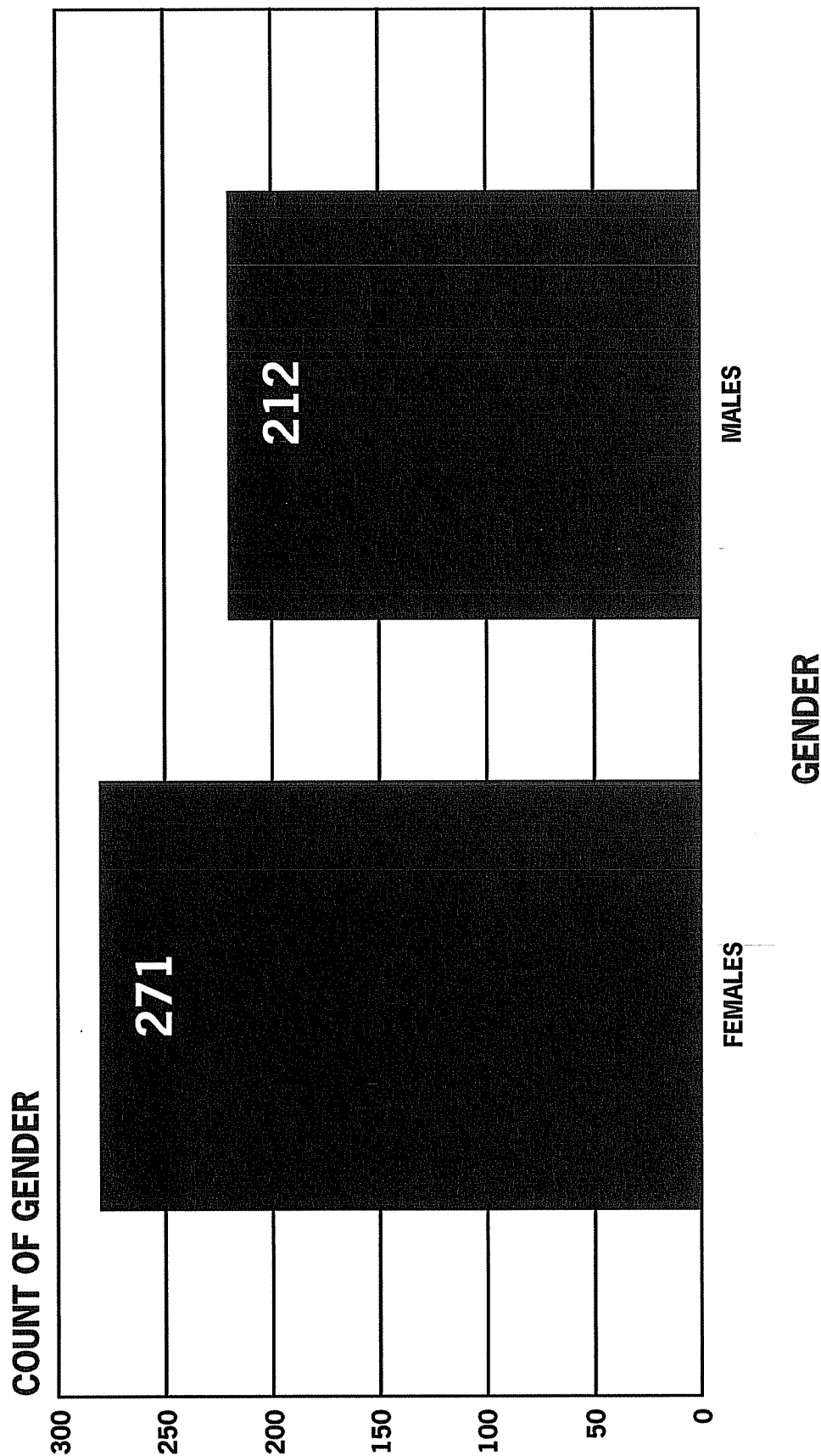

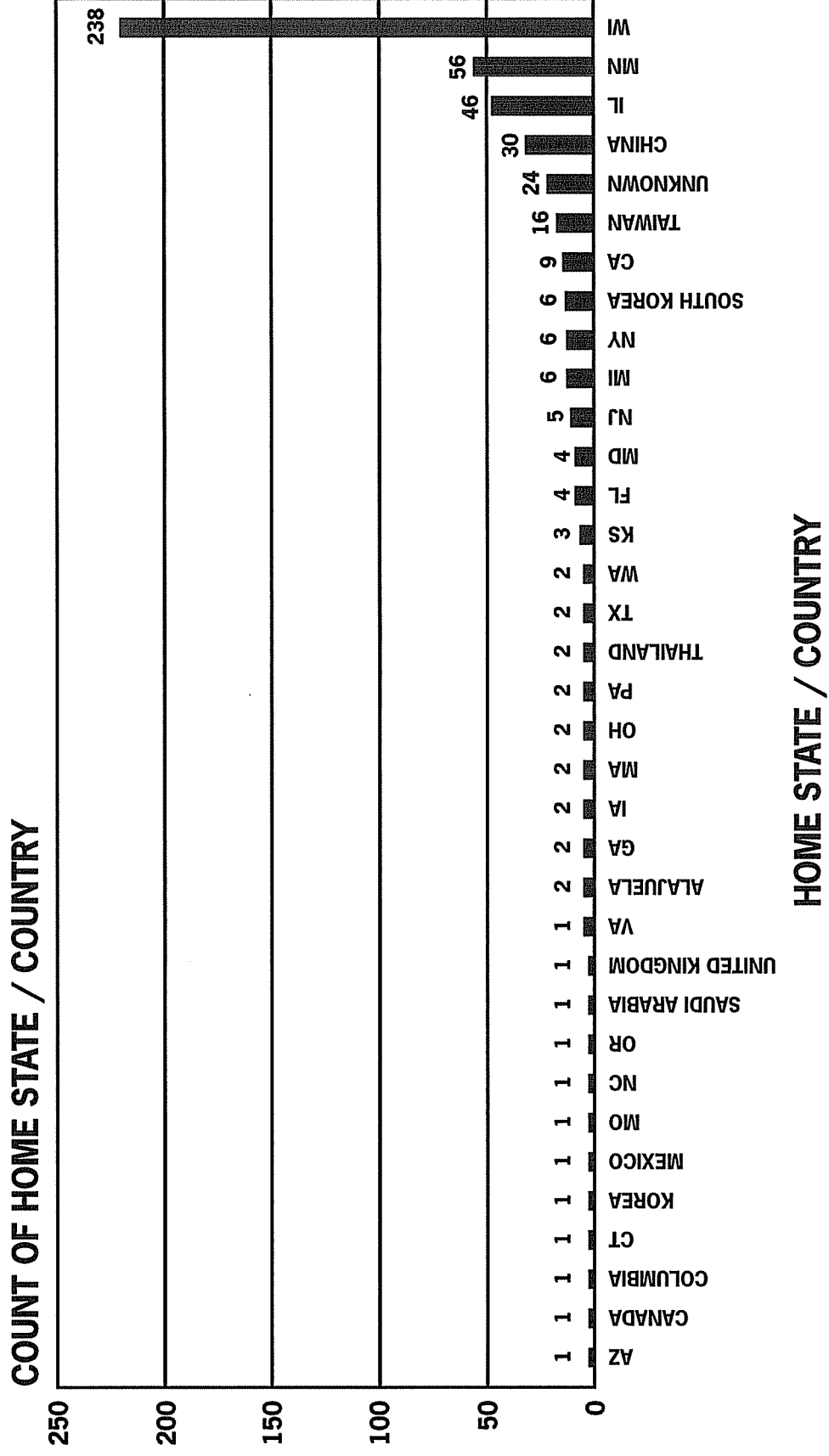
TOTAL NUMBER OF PERSONS CURRENTLY AT GRAND CENTRAL BY AGE
