

Median Safety Ordinance

MGO Sec. 12.325 - Entering or Staying upon Highways Restricted

All covered highways are listed within the ordinance and on the attached map. In addition to the highways highlighted in red, the ordinance covers the first 200 feet of intersecting roads.

Pedestrians must **NOT:**

- » Be on a covered highway or median and approach any vehicle that is not legally parked.
- » Stand in the median without crossing the covered highway in a crosswalk or safety zone.

Drivers must NOT:

- » Park, stop or leave standing your vehicle on a covered highway where it is prohibited.
- » Suddenly decrease your vehicle's speed to respond to someone illegally on the covered highway.
- » Suddenly deviate from traffic to respond to someone illegally on the covered highway.

If you violate this ordinance you could receive a citation for up to \$439.00. Fine amounts for multiple offenses within a year:

1st\$	92.50	3r
$2nd\ldots$ \$	187.00	4t

 3rd \$ 313.00

 4th \$ 439.00
