

DANE COUNTY NARCOTICS TASK FORCE

ANNUAL 2021 SUMMARY

The Dane County Narcotics Task Force (DCNTF) is comprised of women and men from the City of Madison Police Department, Dane County Sheriff's Office, and the UW-Madison Police Department. Additionally, all Law Enforcement agencies in Dane County have the authority to send personnel to work with the DCNTF on shorter assignments as their own staffing allows. The mission of the DCNTF is to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations within the Dane County area. The DCNTF also collaborates with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies in an effort to combat larger drug trafficking organizations.

At the start of 2021, the priorities of this unit continued to focus on disrupting the supply of opioids in Dane County along with gun violence associated with drug trafficking. Emerging trends showed an increase in fentanyl sales. Many times users were under the impression they were purchasing heroin but instead were sold fentanyl. This included users purchasing what they believed were Percocet pills and instead given fentanyl designed to look like prescription Percocet pills. A public safety bulletin was disseminated reference this trend.

Another priority of 2021, was the reduction of gun violence associated with drug trafficking. DCNTF worked jointly with area law enforcement to focus on drug related gun violence. In 2021, DCNTF seized 48 firearms and issued 46 firearms related charges. This included 31 Federal Felon in Possession of a Firearm charges. DCNTF had an increase of 26% firearms seized this year.

The DCNTF also continued to track the increase of methamphetamine trafficking and use.


Enforcement of drug laws is the primary mission of the DCNTF. The unit is also responsive to community and media requests for information pertaining to local drug enforcement and drug education. The DCNTF is also an active participant in the "Stop the Opioid Epidemic" steering committee, which is comprised of a wide range of non-law enforcement community stakeholders that are working collectively to curb the opioid crisis. DCNTF also collaborates with the Madison Area Addiction Recovery Initiative (MAARI).

DCNTF also worked with Public Health and Safe Communities Madison Dane County with drug take back events. This is a nationwide initiative to reduce unused medications and drugs in homes. Wisconsin had 261 participating law enforcement agencies making it #1 in the Nation. Wisconsin had 300 collection sites with 15 of those in Dane County also making it #1 in the Nation. Lastly, Wisconsin collected 57,377 pounds of unused drugs again making it #1 in the Nation.

While enforcement is a critical component of combating illegal drugs and the correlating criminal activity, we recognize that this is only one part of the community effort that is necessary to reduce drug trafficking and drug dependency. We will continue to partner with those both inside and outside of Law Enforcement as we combat this public health and public safety issue.


