## **Types of Force Used By Officers**

From July 1st through September 30th of 2023, Madison Police Officers responded to 39,531 calls for service. In that time, there were 111 citizen contacts in which officers used recordable force\* during their encounter. This means that in the 3rd quarter, MPD officers used recordable force 0.28% of the time when engaging with our citizens. Each of these force incidents documented by officers was reviewed for compliance with MPD standard operating procedures.
