This report highlights the work carried out by Amigos en Azul members and the impact of agencies that continue to support participation in this shared mission.



Our Mission Statement

Fútbol con Amigos

Fútbol con Amigos continues to provide youth and families opportunities to connect with local law enforcement through recreation and positive interactions. In 2025, the program was hosted at **Lincoln Elementary School in Madison**, **McKee Farms Park in Fitchburg** and **Sheehan Park in Sun Prairie**. With food served and equipment provided, families only needed to show up and enjoy the day, completely free of charge.

Youth ages 6 to 16 participated in structured soccer sessions where Amigos en Azul members and volunteers served as coaches, referees and mentors. As they do every year, **La Barra 608** showed their support by volunteering and helping promote our initiative. While the format remained consistent, each event emphasized inclusion, encouragement and positive engagement in a fun environment.

This year, we welcomed over thirty participants. After each session, participants were recognized with medals for **sportsmanship, leadership and good attitude**, reinforcing values that extend beyond the field and into everyday life.





Car Seat Clinic & Vehicle Inspection Event

The Car Seat Clinic & Vehicle Inspection Event continues to be a cornerstone of Amigos en Azul's commitment to family and community education. In 2025, the event expanded its reach through broader collaboration with organizations and service providers from across Dane County.

In partnership with **Safe Kids Madison Area** and the **Fitchburg Police and Fire Departments**, families received hands-on assistance with proper car seat installation, with 45 car seats inspected, and access to free car seats when needed. Activities such as meeting the **Mounted Patrol** from the **UW-Madison Police Department**, facepainting and food from **Parroquia el Buen Pastor**, created a welcoming, family-friendly environment.



Latino Youth Academy

The Latino Youth Academy is designed to equip youth with practical skills, exposure and confidence through direct engagement with local law enforcement and community partners. The program creates opportunities for learning, leadership development and positive interaction in a structured, supportive setting.

In partnership with the **Madison and Fitchburg Police Department**, and other community collaborators, the academy serves youth entering 7th and 8th grade, with a focus on reaching those who may have limited access to public safety education. Participants and their families represent diverse backgrounds across Mexico, Central and South America.

Through the weeklong program, youth engage in hands-on learning experiences that emphasize leadership, communication, goal setting and teamwork. Participants gain firsthand insight into the roles and responsibilities of first responders while building skills that support academic success, personal growth and community engagement.

The academy concludes with a graduation celebration attended by families and community members marking not just the completion of a program, but the beginning of lasting relationships rooted in trust and understanding.





Manejando en Wisconsin

In 2025, Amigos en Azul continued **Manejando en Wisconsin**, a monthly Spanish-language radio program on **La Movida** designed to make traffic safety information accessible and relevant to the Latino Community. Sponsored by **WisDOT, NHTSA and the Dane County Traffic Safety Commission**, produced in partnership with **Safe Communities**, the program prioritizes education through culturally responsive engagement.

The program reached thousands of listeners through on-air discussions, live call-ins and online comments, creating space for community voices and questions. Topics included school zone and bike safety, distracted driving, impaired driving and seatbelt use, issues that directly impact families and everyday mobility.

By removing language, cultural and access barriers, **Manejando en Wisconsin** demonstrates how engagement-driven strategies can promote safer behaviors and reduce roadway risk, particularly in spaces where traditional enforcement alone is not enough.



Responding to Community & School Requests

In addition to Amigos-led initiatives, a significant part of our work involves responding to requests from community organizations and schools across Dane County.

Through 2025, Amigos en Azul participated in a variety of community and school based events. These included resources fairs and engagement opportunities such as **Hawthorne Elementary Parent Night**, youth focused education at the **West High School Equity Symposium** and the **Verona High School Latino Leadership Summit**, and participated in events like **Centro's Caminos Program Networking Night** and **Reach Dane Community Helpers**.

Responding to these requests allows Amigos en Azul to remain present, accessible and responsive to evolving community priorities. By engaging in familiar spaces and on community terms, we continue to strengthen connections and provide meaningful support through education, dialogue and visibility.



2025 Extra Mile Award: Community Ally

Amigos en Azul was proudly honored with the **Extra Mile Award** at Madison's Premier Gala **Rhumba 4 Rainbow**, hosted by **The Rainbow Project**.

Amigos en Azul was recognized for its meaningful collaboration with The Rainbow Project, particularly through the workshops provided for Rainbow's **De Mujer a Mujer** support group-creating spaces rooted in safety, understanding and empowerment.

We are honored to be recognized by an organization whose work centers healing, compassion and hope for children and families. This award reaffirms the importance of collaboration and reinforces our belief that meaningful change happens when organizations come together to support children, families and communities with empathy and care. We share this award with the community and partners who make this work possible every day.



Amigos Phone & Social Media
