Pre-arrest Diversion

This pathway allows eligible individuals to enter a treatment program instead of facing criminal charges.

Referral at a glance:

- Officer writes a citation for possession, paraphernalia, prostitution, etc. instead of booking into jail
- Individual must call MARI Clinician to schedule a free assessment within 5 days (608-405-0445)
- Participate in 6 months of substance use treatment determined by ASAM assessment
- Charges are never forwarded or go on someone's record upon program completion



Self-referral

Individuals in our community that want to take advantage of our free ASAM assessment and get connected with treatment do not need charges to self-refer and participate voluntarily.

Participation at a glance:

- Intensity of treatment (residential, outpatient, etc.) is determined by the ASAM
- MARI participants will work with a peer specialist from Safe Communities to walk alongside them in their recovery journey
- MARI participants are required to check in every other week with our MARI Clinician



Resource Team Outreach

Our Resource Team (RT) makes visits to individuals in the community who have experienced a substance use event with a first responder.

Outreach at a glance:

- The Resource Team consists of an MPD officer and peer specialist from Safe Communities
- They contact individuals in person and via phone who have experienced; an overdose, loss of a loved one from an overdose, documented substance use, and/or documented withdrawal symptoms.
