Service Lines:

- **Fire and Emergency Medical Services Response:**
 - 9 Medic Units, 12 Engines, 5 Ladders, 14 Stations
 - Rapid response times, staffing levels that meet and exceed national levels
 - ISO Class 1 rated department
 - Hazardous Materials, Lake Rescue, Technical Rescue, Fire Investigation
- **Community Fire and EMS education and outreach:**
 - School/neighborhood/community group visits, tours, and discussions
 - CPR education
- **Community Risk Reduction:**
 - Routine fire inspections (twice per year)
 - Smoke detector information
 - Fire Prevention Month – community and school-based activities
 - Grilling safety/outdoor burning safety
 - Building plan review for fire and occupant safety related to new construction
- **Community Paramedicine:**
 - Community Paramedics to make home visits, assisting patients in understanding and fully accessing resources to fulfill their health care needs
 - CARES (Community Alternative Response to Emergency Services) Team to provide crisis response to non-violent behavioral health emergencies. As an alternative to law enforcement, responds with one MFD paramedic and one Journey Mental Health crisis worker.
