Program name	Description
Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program	The Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) can help pay your heating and electric costs. It can also help during an energy crisis. Funds can reach up to \$1,000 per family. It combines programs such as the federally funded Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and Wisconsin’s Public Benefits.
Keep Wisconsin Warm/Cool Fund (KWW/CF)	Financial assistance is available to help keep the heat and power on in your home through KWW/CF. It also offers assistance with payment plans, budget and money counseling, and can connect you with other helpful resources to meet your other basic survival needs. Even if you do not meet the income requirements for LIHEAP, you may still qualify for KWW/CF.
Hometown Care Energy Fund	You can receive up to \$500 toward your heating and cooling costs through Alliant Energy’s Hometown Care Energy Fund. The funds are administered by Energy Services, Inc.
Arrears Management Program	This program helps customers bring past-due account balances to \$0 in just 12 months by paying your monthly energy bill on time. Each time you pay your current monthly bill, we forgive 1/12 of the past-due balance.
Wisconsin Help for Homeowners (WHH)	WHH offers help with overdue bills like mortgage payments (or other overdue housing-related bills), property taxes, utilities and more.
Other resources to consider	Reach out to your local Salvation Army, United Way, church, veteran groups and food pantries for additional assistance to help you in your time of need.
