










A park master plan is...

-  A framework plan
-  Used to identify and develop concepts for additions, replacements or improvements to the park
-  Long Term: 15-20 year outlook
-  Created with input from a broad cross section of community members
-  Is followed by additional meetings and discussions to finalize designs

A park master plan is not...

-  A “shovel ready” construction document
-  Budgeted for, or ready to be built out in a few years
-  Developed with input *only* from neighbors adjacent to the park and those most active at the park today
-  Going to fully meet the needs and desires of everyone
