# 2023 Streets Division Drop-off Sites

## Who can use the drop-off sites?

Only City of Madison residents and property taxpayers are eligible to use the sites. You must be able to provide proof of residency or taxpayer status in order to drop off items.

Contractors may not use the sites.

## Drop-off site limits

You can only make 1 trip a day to the sites.

The single load must not exceed what would fit into a standard truck bed or small 5' x 8' single axle trailer.

Oversized loads will be denied use of the sites.

## Fees

If you are dropping off an item that requires a fee, you must have the appropriate fee sticker attached to the item before the item will be accepted.
