2024 Streets Division Drop-off Sites

Who can use the drop-off sites?

Only City of Madison residents and property taxpayers are eligible to use the sites. You must be able to provide proof of residency or taxpayer status in order to drop off items.

Contractors may not use the sites.

Drop-off site limits

You can only make 1 trip a day to the sites.

The single load must not exceed what would fit into a standard truck bed or small 5' x 8' single axle trailer.

Oversized loads will be denied use of the sites.

Resource Recovery Special Charge & Fee Items

If your home pays the Resource Recovery Special Charge on your Municipal Services bill, then you do not need to pay a recycling fee before taking certain items to a drop-off site.

If you do not pay the Resource Recovery Special Charge, then you must pay the required fee for the select items that have an additional cost before bringing the item to a drop-off site.
