## Explaining the chart:

In Round 1, everyone's first place votes were tallied. No one candidate received a majority of support.

The 58 ballots who voted for Eb-brine-eezer had their votes distributed to the next ranked choice on their ballots for Round 2 .
Also in Round 2, you will see that there were 3 "exhausted ballots." That means 3 ballots only chose Eb-brine-eezer Scrooge and they made no other rankings. Since there were no candidates to receive those three votes, they become "exhausted."
In Round 2, again no majority was found, so the next lowest vote-getter was eliminated - Haline Dugan, PhD.
The 78 votes of Haline were redistributed to the other rankings on their ballots for Round 3.
You'll see that there are now 15 "exhausted ballots."

This means 15 people voted for only Haline or Eb-brine-eezer without ranking other candidates. And since these candidates are eliminated, those ballots are now considered exhausted.
That process repeated itself for 14 Rounds looking for a name that received a mathematical majority of support of the ballots. Since no name achieved that, Saltimus was declared the
winner as it had the most votes by the final elimination round

## Snowbi Wan Kenobi wins!

Snowbi Wan Kenobi achieved a mathematical majority of support in Round 14. A mathematical majority required at least 1,771 votes, and Snowbi received 1,910.

In Round 1, everyone's first place votes were tallied. No one candidate received a majority of support.
The 26 ballots who voted for Spokes'man had their votes distributed to the next ranked choice on their ballots for Round 2.
Also in Round 2, you will see that there were 2 "exhausted ballots." That means 2 ballots only chose Spokes'man and they made no other rankings. Since there were no candidates to receive those 2 votes, they become "exhausted."
In Round 2, again no majority was found, so the next lowest vote-getter was eliminated - Plowaton.
The 49 votes for Plowaton were redistributed to the other rankings on their ballots for Round 3.
You'll see that there are now 3 "exhausted ballots."

This means 3 ballots voted for only Spokes'man or Plowaton without ranking other candidates. Since these candidates are eliminated, those ballots are now considered exhausted.
That process repeated itself for 14 Rounds looking for a name that received a mathematical majority of support of the ballots. And finally in Round 14 , the final elimination round, Snowbi Wan Kenobi was found to have received a mathematical majority of support.
