

RECYCLABLES ONLY

PLASTICS



- » Containers #1 thru #7
- » Bottles – leave on lids
- » Dairy tubs and lids
- » Milk jugs
- » Laundry bottles
- » Berry and deli containers
- » Clamshell and blister packs

Plastic bags must be bagged in clear or white bags:



PAPER



- » Corrugated cardboard
- » Phone books
- » Boxes
- » Newspaper & all inserts
- » Envelopes & junk mail
- » Paper bags
- » Magazines
- » Milk cartons
- » Juice boxes
- » Gable top containers

Shredded paper must be bagged in clear or white bags:



METAL



- » Aluminum cans
- » Steel & tin cans
- » Pots & pans
- » Small metal appliances
- » Empty aerosol cans
- » Metal less than 18 inches long and less than 10 pounds

Bottle caps & other small metal objects must be inside a pinched metal can:



GLASS



- » Bottles – remove caps
- » Jars – remove lids

NO

- » Trash
- » Electronics
- » Hazardous waste
- » Batteries
- » Styrofoam
- » Yard waste
- » Brush
- » Rocks, bricks, concrete
- » Hoses
- » Christmas lights
- » Fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- » Diapers
- » Clothes
- » Bubble wrap
- » Dishes
- » And other items that cannot be recycled in this system.

Rules



- » All recyclables should be free from debris.
- » Most recyclables should be loose in the cart.
- » Keep lid closed because rain and snow ruins paper.
- » Place cart for collection at least 4 feet from any obstruction.
