Safe Streets Madison—April 24, 2024, Transportation Commission Project Description Narrative:

City Traffic Engineering is proposing 29 projects for a total cost estimate of \$1,108,000. Projects include:

- RRFB's--at the following five locations:
  - 1. Cross Country Road at Ice Age Junction Trail
  - 2. Park Street at Chandler Street
  - 3. Raymond Road at Frisch Road
  - 4. Olin Avenue at Lake Court
  - 5. Gorham Street at North Blount Street
- Sidewalk or path construction to fill gaps at the following six locations:
  - 1. West side of South Thompson Road just south of Cottage Grove Road
  - 2. North side of Nelson Road from Highway 151 path east to Morgan Way
  - 3. South side of West Badger Road just east of South Park Street to connect to the future Center for Black Excellence and Culture
  - 4. Blaine Drive just east of School Road to provide an uninterrupted walk route to Mendota Elementary School
  - 5. South side of Lien Road from Parkside Drive to the east 1,100 feet to the Lien Road & Thierer Road intersection
  - 6. The east side of the South Stoughton Road Service Road between the pedestrian overpass bridge at Portland Parkway and the future Occupy Madison site
- Pavement markings at the following 10 locations:
  - 1. Lane designations on Mills Street at Regent Street
  - 2. Contra-flow bike lane connection between Spring Street and Regent Street
  - 3. Additional lane designation arrows on North Lake Street and North Frances Street between West Johnson Street and University Avenue
  - 4. Bike lanes on South Mills Street between Erin Street and Wingra Drive
  - 5. Westbound bike lane connection on Aberg Avenue at North Sherman Avenue
  - 6. Road diet on Lien Road between East Washington Avenue and Thierer Road
  - 7. Bike boulevards on Ziegler Road, Stein Avenue, and Portland Parkway to connect new Autumn Ridge Path
  - 8. Green bike markings at the Whitney Way ramps at the Beltline Highway
  - 9. Green bike markings at the Mineral Point Road ramps at the Beltline Highway
  - 10. Green bike markings at the Cottage Grove Road ramps at the Beltline Highway
- Traffic signal improvements at the following seven locations:
  - 1. Yellow reflective borders for the signal heads on University Avenue at Park Street
  - 2. Left turn arrow infrastructure for northbound Frances Street at University Avenue
  - 3. Left turn arrow infrastructure for Midvale Boulevard at Odana Road
  - 4. Left turn arrow infrastructure for Midvale Boulevard at Tokay Boulevard
  - 5. Pedestrian countdown timers for University Avenue and Johnson Street from Park Street to Bassett Street
  - 6. Pedestrian countdown timers for University Avenue and Johnson Street from Basset Street to Wisconsin Avenue
  - 7. Bike detection for Whitney Way at the Beltline Highway
- Two other concrete projects including:
  - 1. A single speed hump on Jackson Quarry Lane at the Harmony Apartments
  - 2. A median widening project on South Park Street at Haywood Drive to provide adequate space for the installation of the previously approved RRFB at this location.
