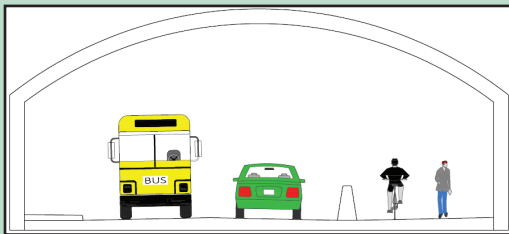


Project Overview

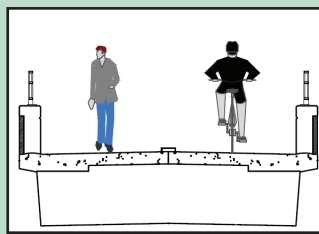
The City of Madison received the Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods federal grant. This federal funding will support planning and feasibility efforts for the proposed Perry Street Overpass project which is a key component of the City's strategy to revitalize South Madison's neighborhoods and address longstanding mobility needs

The study will explore a proposed extension of Perry Street over the Beltline that will allow vehicles, buses, pedestrians, and cyclists to access the businesses located south of the highway. This crossing would connect communities north of the Beltline Highway with employment opportunities and services south of the Beltline Highway.

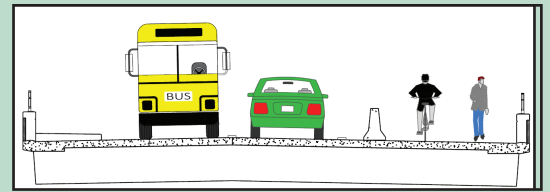
Proposed Connections

and vehicles

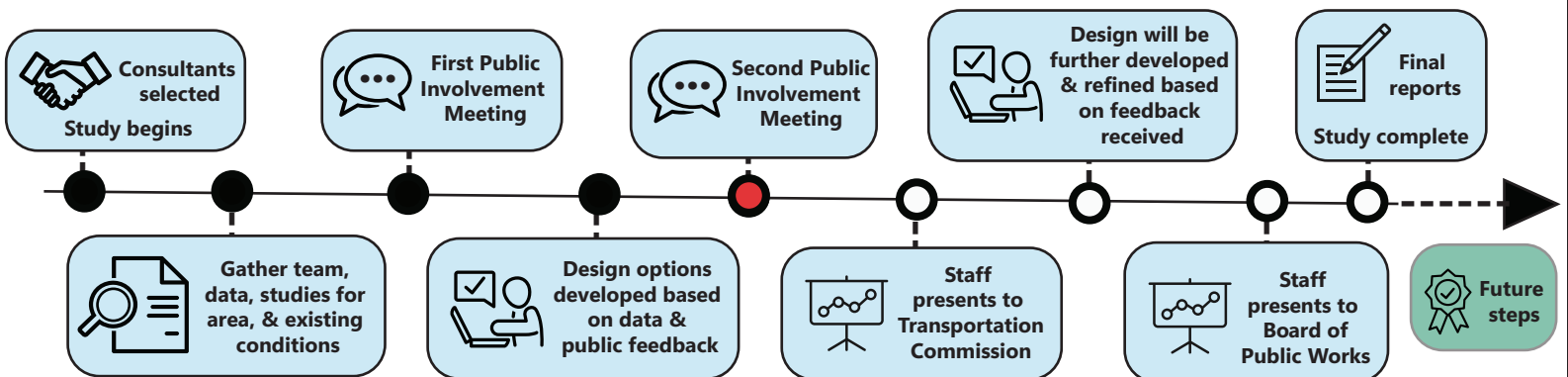


Overpass

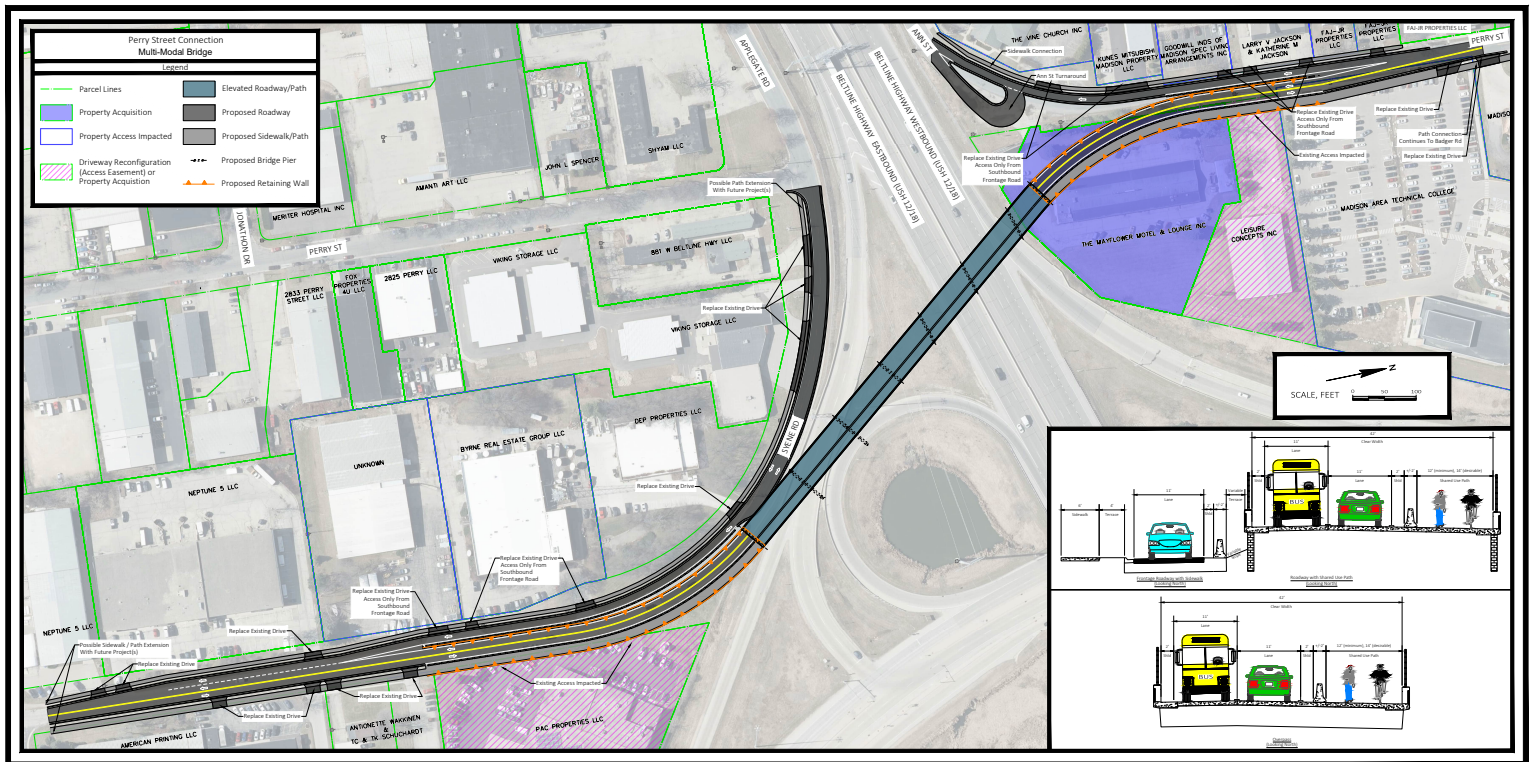
