



# What is MadCAP?

The Madison Customer Assistance Program, or MadCAP, is a program that offers monthly bill credits, or discounts, to low-income customers on their Municipal Services Bill. The MadCAP program credit spreads across all municipal services on the utility bill, including, water, sewer, stormwater, urban forestry, resource recovery, and landfill.

# Why? What's the benefit?

Being able to afford housing is important, and paying for housing also means paying for utilities. MadCAP can help reduce utility costs for low-income residents. It helps keep Madison more affordable and provides relief to low-income residents by giving eligible households a credit of \$20 or \$30 (based on income) off their monthly bills.

## When will MadCAP benefits start?

Applications will be accepted as of March 1, 2023. Participating customers will start receiving the benefit in the billing cycle after their application is approved.

## Who is eligible?

Households at or below 50% of area median income (AMI) that pay their own Municipal Services Bill. Area median income levels are shown in the chart. As a comparison, households eligible for Section 8, Wisconsin FoodShare or SNAP benefits, or WIC benefits are likely to meet MadCAP income limits. Additionally,

homeowners who participate must show participation in a water conservation program. This is not required of participating renters.

## What assistance is offered?

Monthly bill credits on the Madison Municipal Services bill are offered to eligible low-income customers based on how much money households have in earnings <u>each year</u>.

- Households earning 30% or less of AMI will be credited \$30 per month
- Households earning between 30% and 50% of AMI will be credited \$20 per month
